Starting on September 1, 2024, the grant project "European Statistics Competition in Romania 2024-2025" commenced. The project will last 12 months, running from September 2024 to August 2025. Romania's participation in this international competition will be a first for our country; the organization of this initiative by the European Commission (Eurostat) has reached, at the European level, in the 2024-2025 school year, its eighth edition. The European Statistics Competition in Romania (ESC) 2024-2025 targets secondary school students and is organized by the National Institute of Statistics in collaboration with the Ministry of Education.

Its main objective is to promote curiosity and interest in statistics, to encourage teachers to use new materials for teaching statistics, and to highlight the role of statistics for students and teachers in various aspects of society. The competition is aimed at two categories of students from secondary education: students from 9th and 10th grades of the national education system (Junior Category) and students from 11th and 12th grades of the national education system (Senior Category).
