A FEW CONSIDERATIONS

The Romanian Official Statistics was founded in 1859, the same year when the Romanian National State was created.

On July 12th, 1859, Prince Alexandru Ioan Cuza signed the Royal Ordinance establishing the Central Office of Statistical Administration of Wallachia coordinated by Dionisie Pop Marţian. For Moldavia, a similar institution had been created on July 1st, 1859, led by the scholar Ion Ionescu de la Brad.

On August 2nd, 1862, the statistical offices of Wallachia and Moldavia got together and became the Department of Statistics of the United Principalities, based in Bucharest.

Over the time, the development of statistics has naturally followed the path of our history, with ups and downs.

With the accession of Romania to the European Union on January 1st, 2007 and with the harmonization with the acquis communautaire, Romanian statistics reoccupied its rightful place among the modern international statistics. The universally recognized performances were achieved through the Romanian statisticians' efforts and with the support of the European Community.

The National Institute of Statistics of Romania is led by a President, assisted by three Vice-Presidents and a Secretary General, appointed by the Prime Minister's decision

There are 8 Regional Statistical Directorates and 34 County Statistical Directorates that are subordinated to the NIS. The share of higher educated staff is 88.50%.

Through the efforts of our specialists in the territory the information are gathered, validated, processed, analyzed, and centralized and then delivered to the users of statistical data.

We invite you to read the following pages to get to know our structure and main activities, as well as some new aspects in the field of statistics. The presentation order of our directorates being a random one, we invite you to get acquainted first to that through which Romanian statistics are interconnected with the European Statistical System.





The structure and the main responsibilities of the directorate:

The Department of European Affairs and International Cooperation

- We design the harmonization strategies of Romanian statistics with the EU standards and monitor the implementation programmes of these strategies:
- We support the programmes of intensifying the bilateral and regional cooperation;
- We support the proactive participation in the European and international structures;
- We provide the translations for the entire statistical activity.

The Department of International Statistics

- We provide the databases of European and international institutions with statistical data comparable to those of Romania;
- We fill in the guestionnaires and send them to the international bodies;
- We issue the international statistical publications;
- We do researches on Romania's ranking among other countries.


The Unit for the Implementation of Projects and Programs

• We manage the projects with non-reimbursable external funding.

- We coordinate the drawing up of the cooperation agreements between the National Institute of Statistics and the ministries and other central governmental institutions to regulate the exchange of information and increase the use of administrative data sources:
- We monitor the performance of statistical activities within the deadlines provided in the activity plan;
- We perform the activities of the externally financed "Urban Audit" projects;
- We regularly track and report the progress of the achievement of the objectives and priority measures included in the Governmental Programme on statistical activity.







- ... official statistics are organized and operate on the basis of Law No. 226/2009, amended, and fully comply with the EC Regulation No. 223/2009 of the Parliament and of the Council on European statistics, with subsequent amendments?
- ... about 95% of the statistical activities carried out within the national statistical system are for the Eurostat?
- ... annually, the INS runs about 150 statistical researches whose results are disseminated through a number of about 300 press releases and 100 titles of publications?
- ... the SSN development strategies and the annual and multi-annual statistical programmes are approved by Government decision?
- ... the annual national statistical programs are the key tool by which the INS and other producers of official statistics are authorized to collect, store, process, analyze and disseminate the official statistics data?
- ... the INS has a total of 94 conventions and protocols signed with institutional partners for the mutual exchange of statistical data?



Agriculture

- We develop and update the statistical indicators systems, the methodologies and the technical standards that underpin the statistical researches in the field of the national accounts and the governmental finance statistics in accordance with the standards and the norms of the statistical acquis communautaire;
- We develop the annual, quarterly and regional national accounts;
- We develop the statistics on government finance and the excessive deficit procedure;
- We develop the aggregated statistical publications for national accounts.

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is a macroeconomic indicator that reflects the sum of the market value of all goods and services designated for consumption, produced in all the economic branches of a certain country within a year.

THE EVOLUTION OF THE GDP / CAPITA OF ROMANIA COMPARED TO THE EU AVERAGE*



* Note: DGP determined based on the Standard Purchasing Power.

During the last 15 years, the economic development per capita of Romania experienced the highest increase compared to the European average. From a share of 25.5% in 2000, it reached a level of 55.3% in 2014.






- Our mission is to produce reliable indicators in the field of price statistics, using well-founded methodologies strictly complying with the international standards and to deliver these indicators to the decision makers and to the public;
- We calculate, process, validate and provide a system of indicators used for a wide range of purposes: consumer price indices (CPI), the production price indices (the price indices for agricultural products-PIAP, the industrial products price indices – IPPI, the production price indices for services – PPIS), the price indices of the agricultural inputs, the price indices for residential properties and the average prices for the agricultural products;
- We actively participate in the collection, validation and dissemination of the statistical information used for determining the purchasing power parity and the price level indices, within the European Comparing Programme;
- We monitor and implement the methodological standards adopted at international level, through the European legislation or the thematic manuals issued by various international organisations (IMF, OECD, ILO, etc.).

The annual percentage change of the main price indices during the period 2005-2015




- ... the consumer price index (CPI), is an accurate mirror of the inflation?
- ... the IPC family includes two indices: the national CPI and the Harmonised Indices of Consumer Prices (HICP);
- ... the family of industrial production price indices (IPPI) includes three indices: the IPPI for the total, for the domestic market and for the foreign market;
- ... in 2015, Romania had the 8th lowest change in consumer prices of the 28 EU Member States, measured on the basis of the Harmonised Indices of Consumer Prices (HICP);
- ... in the year 2015, Romania had the 12th lowest price adjustment in the production price, of the 28 Member States of the EU, measured on the basis of the IPPI for total;
- ... in 2014, the purchasing power parity in Romania was 2,21197 lei to one euro, as measured by the purchasing power standard at the level of the EU28;
- ... in 2014, Romania ranks second among EU Member States in terms of price, the calculated level for total economy (GDP) of these being about two times lower than the average of the EU28.




- We publish online databases with time series for analyses and socio-economic studies;
- We design query interfaces for online databases as friendly as possible for the users;
- We promptly answer to the data requirements of all categories of users, Romanian and foreign, directing them to the sources of data and metadata that can be accessed online;
- We issue leaflets for the presentation of the products of the NIS and of Eurostat;
- We organize training seminars for the use of data sources online of the NIS and of Eurostat.


The number of statistical data requests






DIRECTORATE OF THE STATISTICAL BUSINESS REGISTER

- The Directorate is referred to as the "spinal column" of business statistics:
- Among the main tasks of the Directorate there are:
 - Coordinate the statistical business surveys (sampling frame, survey plan) and ensure the samples used in the statistical surveys specific for the economic field;
 - Manage the Statistical Business Register (REGIS), according to the requirements of the European regulations;
 - Develop and update the nomenclatures and the classifications of general interest, the methodologies for their use and implementation, respectively: NACE Rev. 2, ISTAUR (Informatics System of the Territorial Administrative Units Register) etc.

The evolution of the new founded enterprises and of the active ones






- > lands in use and crop production;

- forestry;
- economic accounts for environment:
- sustainable development.
- We develop and update the statistical indices system, the methodologies and technical standards on which the achievement of the statistical surveys in agriculture, forestry, logging and environment are based, in accordance with the EU norms and standards;
- We issue synthesis paper works and press releases on specific activities;
- We develop the economic accounts in agriculture the data source for the quarterly and annually calculation of the GDP;
- We develop and update the environmental economic accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Regulation no. 691/2011 of the EC and of the EP and with the European Strategy for Environmental Accounting;
- Every 10 years, we organize and perform the General Agricultural Census;
- We organize the collection, processing, storage and validation of the information obtained through statistical surveys specific to our activity, according to the national annual statistical programme NASP (National Annual Statistical Programme);
- We coordinate, follow and fill in the standard tables, according to the Regulation no. 691/2011 of the EC and EP on European environmental economic accounts, the joint Eurostat / OECD questionnaires for the chapter on inland waters at national and regional level, the joint Eurostat / OECD questionnaire for the chapter on expenditures for environmental protection at national and regional level, the UNECE joint questionnaire, FAO, Eurostat, ITTO forestry statistics and the Eurostat questionnaire economic-environmental integrated account on forestry field;
- We carry out projects with non-refundable external financing to strengthen the statistical system and to improve the quality of statistical data in the field of agriculture, forestry and environment.

The evolution of the GDP and of the domestic material consumption in the period 1994-2013










- We perform the Structural Survey (AS) in enterprises that are the main source of data for the elaboration of the National Accounts;
- We develop statistics in the fields of transport, post and telecommunications, road transport of passengers and goods, data on infrastructure and means of transportation by rail, road, sea, inland waterways, pipelines and air lines and the activity in the field of postal and telecommunications administrations:
- We carry out short term surveys, qualitative surveys, whose purpose is to analyze the
 evolution of the economic indices on short and medium term.

The rate of the gross surplus (%)




- ... the German subsidiaries achieved, during 2009-2014, the largest share of the total turnover of the foreign affiliates located on the territory of Romania?
- ... the short term balance, the base indicator of the short term survey, indicates the perception of the enterprise managers on the dynamics of a phenomenon and not the pace of the value increase or decrease of a statistical index?

- We develop monthly statistics on the Romanian international trade of goods, based on two statistic systems, i.e. Intrastat (the trade operations with EC Member States) and Extrastat (the trade operations with non-EC countries);
- By the Intrastat statistic system, based on monthly statistical quasi-exhaustive research, we collect data from over 20,000 economic operators (over 500,000 transactions monthly);
- In 2015, the NIS was connected to the secure network CCN / CSI, for the micro data transfer between FU Member States and Furostat.

Exports, imports and the trade balance in the period 2010 -2015









- We develop the computer applications for the collection, validation, processing and dissemination of statistical data;
- We check the proper operation of the existing information systems in use in the institution;
- We provide specialized support for both the internal users at the central level and in the territory, as well as for the external users;
- We manage the databases and portal systems installed on the servers of the institute;
- We ensure the development and maintenance of the software products in cooperation with foreign partners.



- We provide the operation and the management of physical and virtual servers existing within the NIS headquarters;
- We provide the operation hardware technical conditions for the web applications which
 record massive traffic, such as http://www.intrastat.ro, the main website of the NIS
 http://www.insse.ro, as well as the portal sites of http://esop.insse.ro/esop-web and
 http://edemos.insse.ro/portal.;
- We provide the support for the statistical data delivery on time to Eurostat through the system eDAMIS (eWA widget + eWP-portal); we provide the technical support for the statistical data transmission to Eurostat through the portal using Web Forms (eWF);
- We provide the necessary technical conditions for a safe operation of the computer networks Extranet, LAN and WAN and of all computing equipments in the NIS;
- We provide the e-mail system Microsoft Exchange and the Internet connections for the whole statistical system of the NIS;
- We provide the technical support for the operation of the acceleration equipments for the applications within the NIS and in the statistical territorial divisions and for the optimization of the data traffic in the network WAN of the NIS;
- We perform the large-volume printouts for the statistical works and we multiply publications in electronic format on CDs and DVDs.


We have the following structure:

- The department of statistical publications editing, graphics and prepress
- The editing department of statistical publications on electronic support
- The traditional and digital copying department

The main activities performed by our directorate are:

- Pre-press activities for all NIS publications, followed by their printing;
- Graphic design of cover pages of all the statistical publications (book and CD);
- Graphic design of the materials for the promotion of the NIS image: leaflets, posters, logos, diplomas;
- The desktop publishing (DTP) of statistical publications: Statistical Yearbook of Romania; International Trade Yearbook of Romania; Demographic Yearbook of Romania; Romania in Figures-statistical summary; Romania Tourism - statistical summary; World Economy in Figures; Monthly Statistical Bulletin of Prices; Monthly Statistical Bulletin of International Trade; Catalogue of Statistical Publications and Services, etc., in both book and electronic format;
- Multiplication of NIS statistical tools:
- Specialized technical assistance for the experts in other NIS departments or in the territory.

- ... With the help of the project initiated in 2002 (supported by PHARE funds and further development of technical base of NIS), no statistical publication is outsourced for printing any longer? This has resulted in significant savings of funds and in easing the implementation effort of the specialized directorates;
- ... We achieved significant savings of funds by creating an archive of photographs used to illustrate statistical publications of NIS, exclusively from own resources;
- ... Over the time, by harmonizing with the requirements of data users, reprints of publications on paper have decreased significantly in favour of their dissemination in electronic format-on CD and on the Internet.



- We ensure the interface between the National Institute of Statistics and the media:
- We manage the public appearances of the institute representatives, interviews and other materials on television, radio and written press;
- We organize activities for the popularization of the statistical culture among the representatives of mass media, through scientific symposiums and training programs among the different categories of target audience;
- We organize actions on communication skills acquisition, press conferences, roundtables, symposiums and other events meant to increase the awareness of the results of the statistical surveys.
