The volume of wood exploited in 2012


In 2012, the economic operators with logging activity reported a volume of round wood exploited by 4.8 % higher compared to 2011.

The distribution of the quantity of wood, exploited by development regions, shows a greater concentration in the North-East region (25.6% of the total volume of exploited wood) and the Centre region (20.9%) and in a smaller proportion in the following regions: North-West (13.6%), West (11.4%), South-Muntenia (10.7%), South-East (9.8%), South-West Oltenia (7.4%) and Bucharest-Ilfov (0.6%).



The manufacturing of logs into sawn wood represented the main designation of the round wood exploited, 57.5 %, which means 2.2 pp more compared to 2011.

Methodological note

- 1. The data source is the statistical survey on "The volume of exploited wood".
- 2. The survey is exhaustive and meant for the economic operators with activity in logging, which exploited timber in 2012. Data have been collected from 3516 economic operators through a statistical questionnaire.
- 3. Data are provisional and can be periodically revised based on adjustments done retroactively by the economic operators.
- 4. Definitions:

The volume of wood exploited – the volume of wood exploited, registered in the documents of the exploitation unit. The following are not considered volume of exploited wood: standing wood mass as well as that fallen down and not harvested from parcels at end of production year. The volume of exploited wood includes: round wood, industrial wood bark and other secondary types.

The volume of round wood – the volume of industrial wood (without bark) and of firewood. **Other types** – the volume of branches, wood residues and technological consumption.
