### The volume of exploited wood in 2014

*In 2014, the volume of the exploited wood reported by the economic operators with logging activity was 1.2% higher than in 2013.*

### The volume of exploited wood in 2014 compared to 2013, by wood species

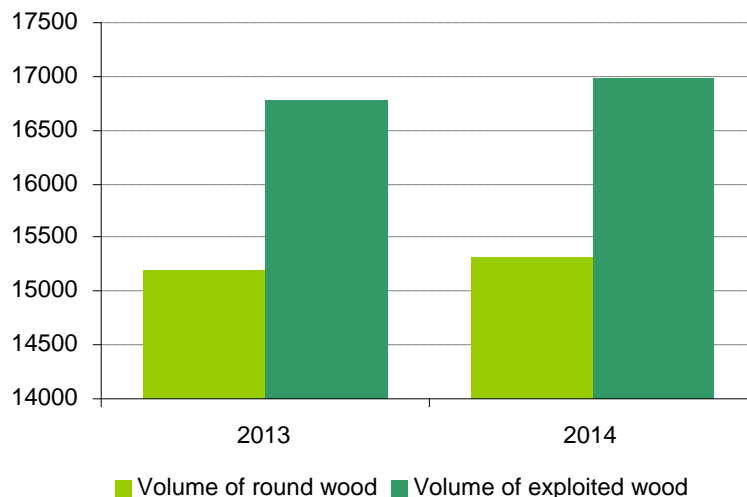

42.7% of the round wood volume represented coniferous and 57.3% hardwood.

### The volume of round timber in 2014 compared to 2013

In 2014, compared to 2013, an increase of 0.9% in the volume of round wood was registered mainly due to an increase of the exploited wood volume.

The manufacturing of logs into sawn timber represented the main destination of exploited round wood, 56.3 % of the total, 1.6 pp more compared to 2013.

#### Methodological note

1. The data source is the statistical survey on „*Volume of exploited wood*“.
2. The statistical survey is exhaustive and addresses the economic operators with forestry activity, harvesting wood in 2014. Data were collected from 3838 economic operators through a statistical questionnaire.
3. Data are provisional and can be revised based on the corrections retroactively done by economic operators.
4. Definitions:

**The volume of the exploited wood** – represents the industrial wood and the fuel wood harvested and collected from the parquet area or from the area affected by accidental products, the one in primary platforms included.

**Volume of round wood** – the volume of industrial wood, fuel wood and charcoal wood.

**Other types** – the volume of branches, remains and technological consumption.
