


Area: ILO unemployment

## In January 2015 the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was estimated at 6.5%

- Unemployment rate in January 2015 - down with 0.1 percentage points as compared to the previous month.
- Men's unemployment rate is higher than that of women with 0.7 percentage points.



Seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased with 0.1 percentage points as compared to the previous month<sup>1</sup> and with 0.5 percentage points as compared to the level recorded in January 2014.

The number of unemployed (aged 15-74 years) estimated for January current year is of 607 thousand persons, decreasing as compared to the previous month (609 thousand persons) as well as compared to the same month of the previous year (648 thousand persons).

According to the breakdown by gender, men's unemployment rate is with 0.7 percentage points higher than that of women (the values concerned are 6.8% for men and 6.1% for women).

The unemployment rate of adult persons (aged 25-74 years) was estimated at 5.2% for January 2015 (5.6% in the case of men and 4.7% in that of women's).

The number of unemployed aged 25-74 years accounts for 73.7% of the total number of unemployed estimated for January 2015.
