## THE TOURISTS' OVERNIGHT STAYS IN THE ESTABLISHMENTS OF TOURISTS' RECEPTION INCREASED BY 14.6%

- In March 2015, compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, both the arrivals and the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 12.3 % and by 14.6 %, respectively.
- Compared to March 2014, in March 2015, customs registered an increase in both the arrivals of foreign visitors of 11.4 % and in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors of 6.3 %.



In March 2015, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 581.3 thousand, 12.3% more compared to March 2014.

In March 2015, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 75.3% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 24.7%, weights close to those of March 2014.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (76.4% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.1% of them came from European Union Member States.

In March 2015, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1157.5 thousand, 14.6% more compared to March 2014.

In March 2015, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 76.1% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 23.9%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (75.5 % of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.7% of them came from European Union Member States.

In March 2015, the average time of stay was 2.0 days for the Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for the foreign tourists.

In March 2015, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 20.6 % on total tourists' accommodation, 2.1 pp more compared to March 2014.

In March 2015, higher indices of accommodation places were registered by hotels (26.4%), inns (22.6%) and hostels (14.9%).

In March 2015, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 604.3 thousand, 11.4% more compared to March 2014. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (93.8%). 60.4% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Hungary (32.6%), Bulgaria (26.8%), Germany (8.6%), Italy (6.8%), Poland (5.2%) and Austria (3.4 %).

In March 2015, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 942.1 thousand, 6.3% more compared to March 2014. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 75.8 % of the total departures.

In Quarter I 2015, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1608.9 thousand, 12.6% more compared to Quarter I 2014.

In Quarter I 2015, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.9% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.1%, weights close to those of Quarter I 2014.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (76.8% of the total of foreign tourists) and 83.0% of them came from European Union Member States.

In Quarter I 2015, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 3213.7 thousand, 14.9% more compared to Quarter I 2014.

In Quarter I 2015, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.9% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign

tourists' overnight stays were 22.1%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (75.8 % of the total of foreign tourists) and 80.4% of them came from European Union Member States.

In Quarter I 2015, the average time of stay was 2.0 days for both the Romanian and the foreign tourists.

In Quarter I 2015, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 20.0 % on total tourists' accommodation, 2.1 pp more compared to Quarter I 2014.

In Quarter I 2015, higher indices of accommodation places were registered by hotels (25.1%), hostels (14.7%) and tourist villas (14.6%).

The most arrivals of foreign tourists accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation \*) were from Italy (41.6 thousand), Germany (38.4 thousand), Israel (28.9 thousand), France (24.5 thousand) and The United Kingdom (22.8 thousand).

In Quarter I 2015, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 1642.6 thousand, 12.4% more compared to Quarter I 2014. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (94.1%). 59.7% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Hungary (32.1%), Bulgaria (29.3%), Germany (7.6%), Italy (6.9%), Poland (5.2%) and Austria (3.1%).

In Quarter I 2015 the departures of Romanian visitors abroad, according to *customs*, amounted to 2814.7 thousand, 10.6% more compared to Quarter I 2014. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 76.6% of the total departures.
