CONSTRUCTION PERMITS RELEASED FOR BUILDINGS IN MAY 2025

- In May 2025, 3364 construction permits were released for residential buildings, an increase of 7.1% compared to April 2025 and a 10.3% rise compared to May 2024.
- In the 1.I-31.V.2025 period, 14134 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 0.6% more than in the 1.I-31.V.2024 period.



May 2025 compared to April 2025

In May 2025, 3364 construction permits were released for residential buildings (+7.1% compared to April 2025), with a total useful floor area of 752850 sq m (+14.1%). 70.9% of the total number of construction permits for residential buildings are for the rural area.

In May 2025, there was an increase of 224 permits in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings compared to the previous month. At regional level, this rise was reflected in the following development regions: North-East (+52 permits), Centre and Bucharest-Ilfov (+46 each), South-West Oltenia (+45), South-Muntenia (+29), West (+4) and South-East (+2). In the North-West development region the construction permits released for residential buildings remained at the same level.

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in May 2025 and April 2025



In May 2025, 576 construction permits were released for non-residential buildings (+13.6% compared to April 2025), with a total useful floor area of 354163 sq m (+29.8%).

In May 2025, there was an increase in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (+81339 sq m) compared to the previous month. At regional level, this rise was reflected in the following development regions: North-East (+83757 sq m), West (+20488) and South-Muntenia (+5879). Drops were reported for the following development regions: South-East (-10139 sq m), Bucharest-Ilfov (-9056), South-West Oltenia (-5986), Centre (-2486) and North-West (-1118).

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in May 2025 and April 2025





May 2025 compared to May 2024

In May 2025, the number of construction permits released for residential buildings increased by 10.3% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+7.8%) compared to May 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings (+314 permits) was reflected in the following development regions: Bucharest-Ilfov (+74 permits), North-West (+58), West (+49), Centre (+46), South-Muntenia (+45), South-East (+25) and North-East (+17). In the South-West Oltenia development region the construction permits released for residential buildings remained at the same level.

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in May 2025 and May 2024






In May 2025, the number of construction permits released for non-residential buildings increased by 11.6% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+36.1%) compared to May 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (+94009 sq m) was reflected in the following development regions: North-East (+77307 sq m), West (+31187), South-Muntenia (+26150), Bucharest-Ilfov (+6886) and South-West Oltenia (+2924). Drops were reported for the following development regions: Centre (-33308 sq m), North-West (-12426) and South-East (-4711).

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in May 2025 and May 2024







The 1.I-31.V.2025 period compared to the 1.I-31.V.2024 period

In the 1.I-31.V.2025 period, 14134 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 0.6% more than in the 1.I-31.V.2024 period.

Rises were reported for the following development regions: West (+166 permits), Centre (+70), North-West (+68), South-East (+36), Bucharest-Ilfov (+30) and South-West Oltenia (+14). Drops were recorded in the North-East (-249 permits) and South-Muntenia (-51) development regions.

✓ A construction permit is a local administration authority act on the basis of which the implementation of the legal measures regarding the location, design, execution and functioning of constructions is ensured.

✓ The development regions include the following counties:

- the North-East development region: Bacău, Botoșani, Iași, Neamţ, Suceava and Vaslui;
- the **South-East** development region: Brăila, Buzău, Constanța, Galați, Tulcea and Vrancea;
- the **South-Muntenia** development region: Argeș, Călărași, Dâmbovița, Giurgiu, Ialomița, Prahova and Teleorman;
- the South-West Oltenia development region: Dolj, Gorj, Mehedinţi, Olt and Vâlcea;
- the West development region: Arad, Caraş-Severin, Hunedoara and Timiş;
- the North-West development region: Bihor, Bistriţa-Năsăud, Cluj, Maramureş, Satu-Mare and Sălaj;
- the **Centre** development region: Alba, Braşov, Covasna, Harghita, Mureş and Sibiu;
- the Bucharest-Ilfov development region: Bucharest Municipality and Ilfov County.
