CONSTRUCTION PERMITS RELEASED FOR BUILDINGS IN JUNE 2025

- In June 2025, 3505 construction permits were released for residential buildings, an increase of 4.2% compared to May 2025 and a 21.9% rise compared to June 2024.
- In the first semester of 2025, 17639 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 4.2% more than in the first semester of 2024.



June 2025 compared to May 2025

In June 2025, 3505 construction permits were released for residential buildings (+4.2% compared to May 2025), with a total useful floor area of 1064306 sq m (+41.4%). 73.2% of the total number of construction permits for residential buildings are for the rural area.

In June 2025, there was an increase of 141 permits in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings compared to the previous month. At regional level, this rise was reflected in the following development regions: North-East (+88 permits), West (+72) and Centre (+36%). Drops were reported for the following development regions: South-Muntenia (-25 permits), South-East (-17), South-West Oltenia (-8), Bucharest-Ilfov (-4) and North-West (-1).

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in June 2025 and May 2025



In June 2025, 677 construction permits were released for non-residential buildings (+17.5% compared to May 2025), with a total useful floor area of 432558 sq m (+22.1%).

In June 2025, there was an increase in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (+78395 sq m) compared to the previous month. At regional level, this rise was reflected in the following development regions: Bucharest-Ilfov (+56467 sq m), North-West (+31530), Centre (+18072), South-West Oltenia (+14517) and South-East (+13111). Drops were reported for the following development regions: North-East (-29147 sq m), South-Muntenia (-15016) and West (-11139).

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in June 2025 and May 2025





June 2025 compared to June 2024

In June 2025, the number of construction permits released for residential buildings increased by 21.9% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+70.1%) compared to June 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings (+630 permits) was reflected in the following development regions: North-East (+204 permits), West (+136), North-West (+110), Centre (+99), South-Muntenia (+61) and South-West Oltenia (+32). Drops were reported in the South-East (-9 permits) and Bucharest-Ilfov (-3) development regions.

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in June 2025 and June 2024



In June 2025, the number of construction permits released for non-residential buildings increased by 32.7% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+105.9%) compared to June 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (+222426 sq m) was reflected in the following development regions: Bucharest-Ilfov (+62171 sq m), West (+46843), North-East (+45339), South-West Oltenia (+18429), North-West (+16376), South-Muntenia (+15372), Centre (+13506) and South-East (+4390).

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in June 2025 and June 2024





The first semester of 2025 compared to the first semester of 2024

In the first semester of 2025, 17639 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 4.2% more than in the first semester of 2024.

Rises were reported for the following development regions: West (+302 permits), North-West (+178), Centre (+169), South-West Oltenia (+46), South-East and Bucharest-Ilfov (+27 each) and South-Muntenia (+10). A drop was recorded in the North-East development region (-45 permits).

✓ A construction permit is a local administration authority act on the basis of which the implementation of the legal measures regarding the location, design, execution and functioning of constructions is ensured.

✓ The development regions include the following counties:

- the North-East development region: Bacău, Botoșani, Iași, Neamţ, Suceava and Vaslui;
- the **South-East** development region: Brăila, Buzău, Constanța, Galați, Tulcea and Vrancea;
- the **South-Muntenia** development region: Argeş, Călăraşi, Dâmboviţa, Giurgiu, Ialomiţa, Prahova and Teleorman;
- the South-West Oltenia development region: Dolj, Gorj, Mehedinţi, Olt and Vâlcea;
- the West development region: Arad, Caraş-Severin, Hunedoara and Timiş;
- the North-West development region: Bihor, Bistriţa-Năsăud, Cluj, Maramureş, Satu-Mare and Sălaj;
- the **Centre** development region: Alba, Braşov, Covasna, Harghita, Mureş and Sibiu;
- the **Bucharest-Ilfov** development region: Bucharest Municipality and Ilfov County.
