CONSTRUCTION PERMITS RELEASED FOR BUILDINGS IN JULY 2025

- In July 2025, 3675 construction permits were released for residential buildings, an increase of 4.9% compared to June 2025 and a 5.4% rise compared to July 2024.
- In the 1.I-31.VII.2025 period, 21314 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 4.4% more than in the 1.I-31.VII.2024 period.



July 2025 compared to June 2025

In July 2025, 3675 construction permits were released for residential buildings (+4.9% compared to June 2025), with a total useful floor area of 1045932 sq m (-1.7%). 69.9% of the total number of construction permits for residential buildings are for the rural area.

In July 2025, there was an increase of 170 permits in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings compared to the previous month. At regional level, this rise was reflected in the following development regions: South-Muntenia (+98 permits), North-West (+57), South-East (+44), South-West Oltenia (+31) and Bucharest-Ilfov (+23). Drops were reported for the following development regions: Centre (-36 permits), West (-32) and North-East (-15).

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in July 2025 and June 2025



In July 2025, 613 construction permits were released for non-residential buildings (-9.5% compared to June 2025), with a total useful floor area of 381972 sq m (-11.7%).

In July 2025, there was a decrease in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (-50586 sq m) compared to the previous month. At regional level, this drop was reflected in the following development regions: West (-33419 sq m), North-East (-28570), Centre (-24052), South-West Oltenia (-13839), South-East (-4466) and North-West (-765). Rises were reported in the South-Muntenia (+42062 sq m) and Bucharest-Ilfov (+12463) development regions.

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in July 2025 and June 2025





July 2025 compared to July 2024

In July 2025, the number of construction permits released for residential buildings increased by 5.4% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+33.5%) compared to July 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings (+188 permits) was reflected in the following development regions: South-West Oltenia (+68 permits), South-Muntenia (+62), North-East (+53), South-East (+40), Bucharest-Ilfov (+37) and West (+29). Drops were reported in the North-West (-64 permits) and Centre (-37) development regions.

Construction permits released for residential buildings, by development regions, in July 2025 and July 2024






In July 2025, the number of construction permits released for non-residential buildings increased by 9.7% and there was a rise in the total useful floor area (+40.0%) compared to July 2024.

At regional level, this rise in the useful floor area as regards the construction permits released for non-residential buildings (+109157 sq m) was reflected in the following development regions: South-Muntenia (+52271 sq m), North-West (+35211), Bucharest-Ilfov (+14717), West (+14357), North-East (+5217) and South-West Oltenia (+2045). Drops were reported in the South-East (-10862 sq m) and Centre (-3799) development regions.

Construction permits released for non-residential buildings, by development regions, in July 2025 and July 2024







The 1.I-31.VII.2025 period compared to the 1.I-31.VII.2024 period

In the 1.I-31.VII.2025 period, 21314 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 4.4% more than in the 1.I-31.VII.2024 period.

Rises were reported for all the development regions: West (+331 permits), Centre (+132), South-West Oltenia and North-West (+114 each), South-Muntenia (+72), South-East (+67), Bucharest-Ilfov (+64) and North-East (+8).

✓ A construction permit is a local administration authority act on the basis of which the implementation of the legal measures regarding the location, design, execution and functioning of constructions is ensured.

✓ The development regions include the following counties:

- the North-East development region: Bacău, Botoșani, Iași, Neamţ, Suceava and Vaslui;
- the **South-East** development region: Brăila, Buzău, Constanța, Galați, Tulcea and Vrancea;
- the **South-Muntenia** development region: Argeş, Călăraşi, Dâmboviţa, Giurgiu, Ialomiţa, Prahova and Teleorman;
- the **South-West Oltenia** development region: Dolj, Gorj, Mehedinţi, Olt and Vâlcea;
- the West development region: Arad, Caraş-Severin, Hunedoara and Timiş;
- the North-West development region: Bihor, Bistriţa-Năsăud, Cluj, Maramureş, Satu-Mare and Sălaj;
- the **Centre** development region: Alba, Braşov, Covasna, Harghita, Mureş and Sibiu;
- the **Bucharest-Ilfov** development region: Bucharest Municipality and Ilfov County.
