CONSTRUCTION PERMITS RELEASED FOR BUILDINGS IN NOVEMBER 2019

- *In November 2019, 3423 construction permits were released for residential buildings, an 8.4% decrease compared to October 2019 and a 5.6% rise compared to November 2018.*
- *In the 1.I-30.XI.2019 period, 39359 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 1.5% less than in the same period of the previous year.*

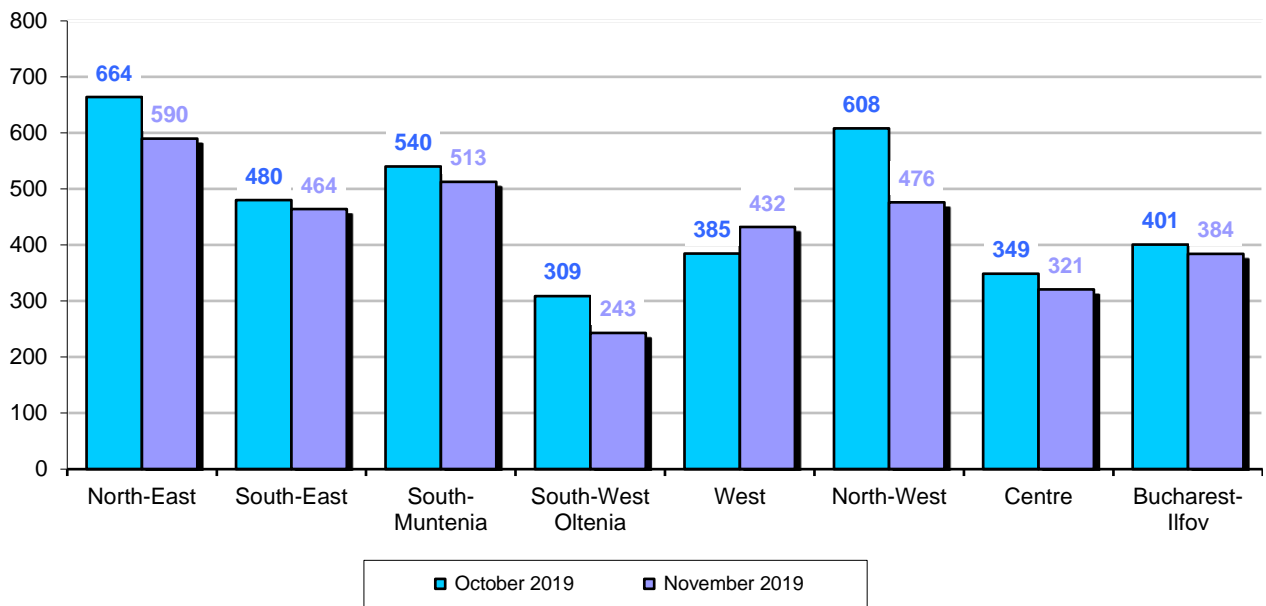
November 2019 compared to October 2019

In November 2019, 3423 construction permits were released for residential buildings, of which 67.7% were for the rural area.

The regional distribution in November 2019 shows a decrease of 313 permits in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings compared to the previous month, with drops reported in the following development regions: North-West (-132 permits), North-East (-74), South-West Oltenia (-66), Centre (-28), South-Muntenia (-27), Bucharest-Ilfov (-17) and South-East (-16). A rise was reported in the West development region (+47 permits).

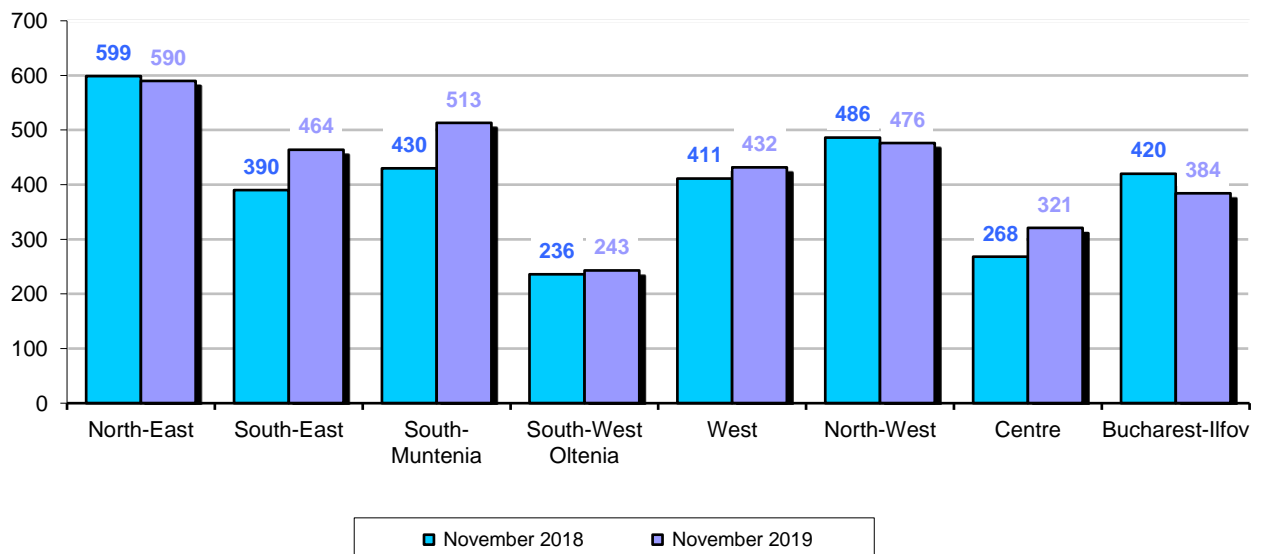

November 2019 compared to November 2018

An increase in the number of construction permits released for residential buildings (+183 permits) was recorded in November 2019 compared to the same month of the previous year, with rises reported in the following development regions: South-Muntenia (+83 permits), South-East (+74), Centre (+53), West (+21) and South-West Oltenia (+7). Decreases were recorded in the following development regions: Bucharest-Ilfov (-36 permits), North-West (-10) and North-East (-9).

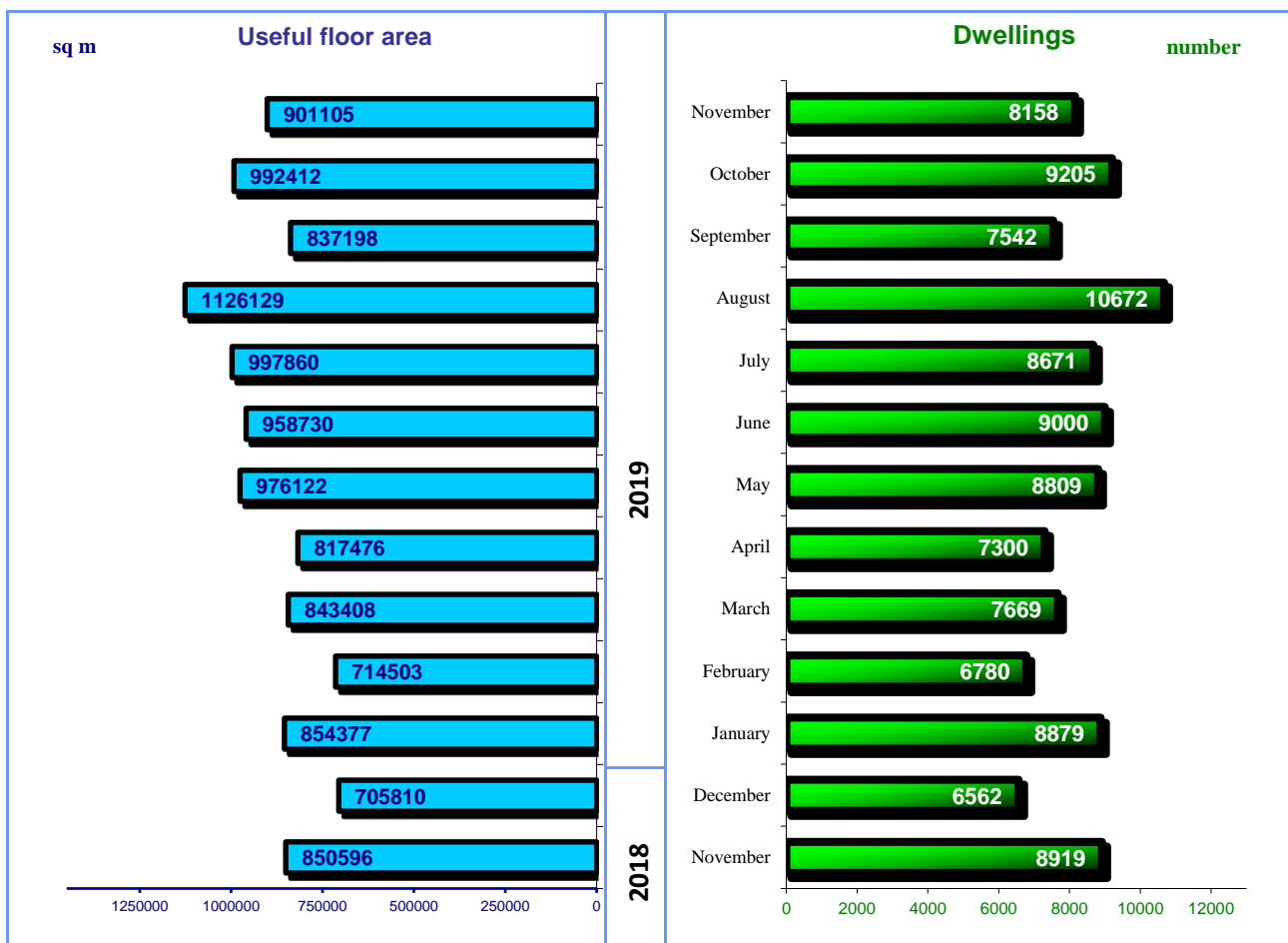

The 1.I-30.XI.2019 period compared to the 1.I-30.XI.2018 period

In the 1.I-30.XI.2019 period, 39359 construction permits were released for residential buildings, 1.5% less than in the 1.I-30.XI.2018 period.

Decreases were recorded in the following development regions: Bucharest-Ilfov (-852 permits), West (-480), North-East (-36) and South-Muntenia (-19). Increases were reported in the following development regions: South-East (+471 permits), Centre (+154), South-West Oltenia (+102) and North-West (+59).
