## In June 2015, compared to the previous month, the number of slaughtered sheep and goats decreased almost 2 times.

• In June 2015, compared to the previous month, the number of slaughtered animals and poultry increased for poultry, decreased for pigs and sheep and goats and remained constant for cattle; the carcass weight increased for cattle, pigs and poultry and decreased for sheep and goats.

• Compared to the same month of 2014, the number of slaughtered animals and poultry increased for cattle, pigs and poultry and remained constant for sheep and goats; the carcass weight increased for cattle, pigs and poultry and decreased for sheep and goats.

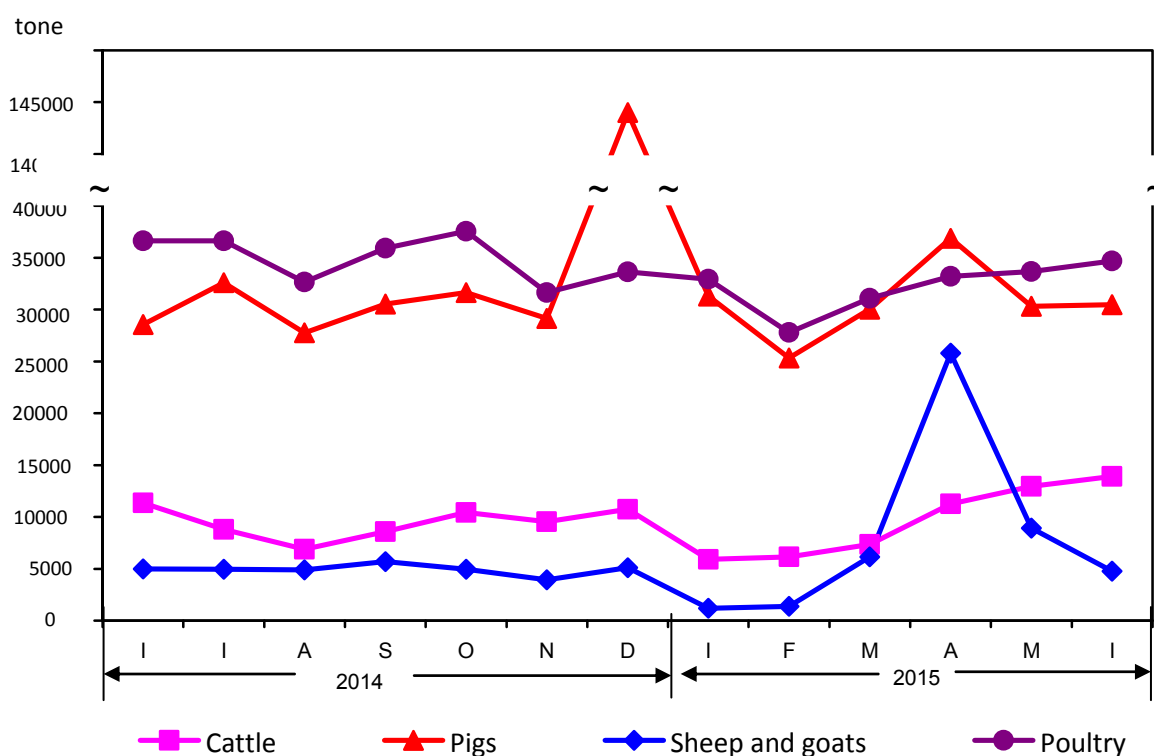
