
Domain: International trade with goods

In January 2015, exports and imports increased by 6.4% and by 4.1%, respectively, compared to January 2014

- In January 2015, according to preliminary estimations of the National Institute of Statistics,
 FOB exports amounted to 4186.6 million euro and CIF imports amounted to 4363.0 million euro.
- Compared to December 2014, in January 2015 exports increased by 10.2% and imports decreased by 4.0%.
- In January 2015 the FOB-CIF commercial deficit was of 176.4 million euro, 76.2 million euro less than in January 2014.

Exports, imports and FOB/CIF balance during January 2010 – January 2015



In January 2015, the Intra-community trade of goods (Intra-EU28) amounted to 3107.8 million euro for dispatches and to 3380.9 million euro for arrivals, representing 74.2% of the total exports and 77.5% of the total imports.


In January 2015, the Extra-community trade of goods (Extra-EU28) amounted to 1078.8 million euro for exports and to 982.1 million euro for imports, representing 25.8% of the total exports and 22.5% of the total imports.

INTRA - EU28 exports and EXTRA - EU28 exports, during January 2013 - January 2015






FOB-CIF balance for INTRA - EU28 and EXTRA - EU28, during January 2013 - January 2015



In January 2015, important weights in the structure of exports and imports are represented by the following groups of goods: transport equipment and vehicles (44.2% for export and 38.0% for import) and other manufacturated goods^{*)} (34.0% for export and 31.2% for import, respectively).
