

# International trade with goods in April and the period 1.I-30.IV 2018

- In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, the FOB exports amounted to 22221.6 million euro and the CIF imports amounted to 25948.7 million euro.
- In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, the exports increased by 9.7% and imports by 10.0%, compared to the period 1.I-30.IV 2017.
- In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, the FOB-CIF commercial deficit was of 3727.1 million euro, 379.3 million euro more than in the period 1.I-30.IV 2017.
- In April 2018, the FOB exports amounted to 5234.3 million euro and the CIF imports amounted to 6245.5 million euro, a commercial deficit of 1011.2 million euro being registered.
- Compared to April 2017, the exports increased by 9.7% and the imports increased by 7.3% in April 2018.

### Exports, imports and FOB/CIF balance during January 2013 - April 2018



In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, important weights in the structure of exports and imports are represented by the following groups of goods: machinery and transport equipment (48.3% for export and 37.3% for import) and other manufactured goods<sup>1)</sup> (32.3% for export and 30.7% for import, respectively).

Note: The differences between total and data obtained by cumulating the different structures used are due to the roundings performed.

In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, the Intra-EU28 trade of goods amounted to 17070.6 million euro for dispatches and to 19648.7 million euro for arrivals, representing 76.8% of total exports and 75.7% of total imports.

In the period 1.I-30.IV 2018, the Extra-EU28 trade of goods amounted to 5151.0 million euro for exports and to 6300.0 million euro for imports, representing 23.2% of total exports and 24.3% of total imports.



### Additional information:

**FOB/CIF trade balance** is calculated on the basis of the FOB export value and CIF import value as difference between them. The negative balance of the trade balance is called deficit and the positive one is called excedent.

**FOB price** (Free on Board) represents **the price at the border of the exporting country**, which includes the value of the commodity, all transport expenditures to the shipping point as well as all the fees for the commodity to be loaded on board.

**CIF price** (Cost, Insurance, Freight) represents **the price** at the border of the importing country, including both components of FOB price and the cost of insurance as well as the cost of the international transport.

For a correct interpretation of the indicators, kindly see the Methodological Notes.
