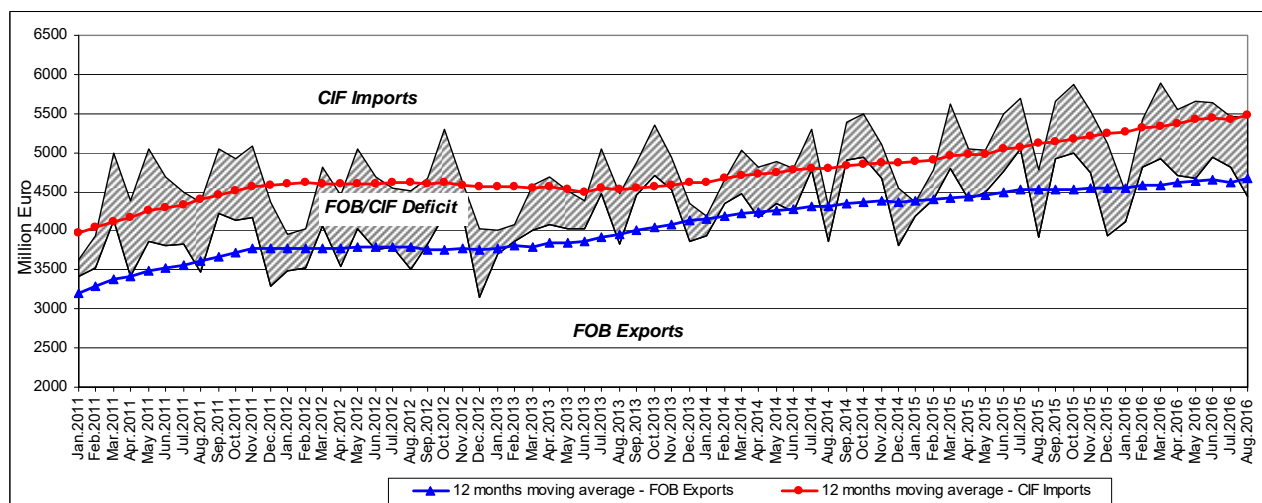


Domain: International trade with goods

In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, the exports and imports increased by 4.0% and by 6.8%, respectively, compared to the period 1.I-31.VIII 2015

- In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, the FOB exports amounted to 37439.4 million euro and the CIF imports amounted to 43573.2 million euro.
- In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, the FOB-CIF commercial deficit was of 6133.8 million euro, 1338.2 million euro more than in the period 1.I-31.VIII 2015.
- In August 2016, the FOB exports were of 4446.9 million euro and the CIF imports were of 5463.0 million euro, a commercial deficit of 1016.1 million euro being registered.
- Compared to August 2015, the exports increased by 13.4% and the imports increased by 14.4% in August 2016.

Exports, imports and FOB/CIF balance during January 2011 – August 2016

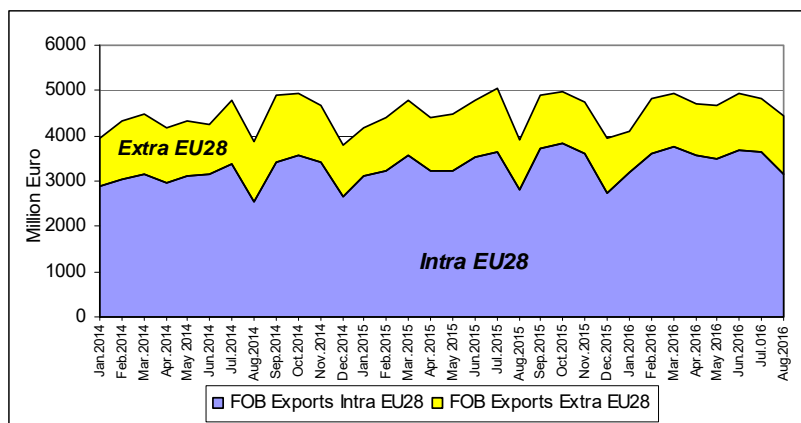

In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, the Intra-community trade of goods (Intra-EU28) amounted to 28072.5 million euro for dispatches and to 33607.5 million euro for arrivals, representing 75.0% of the total exports and 77.1% of the total imports.

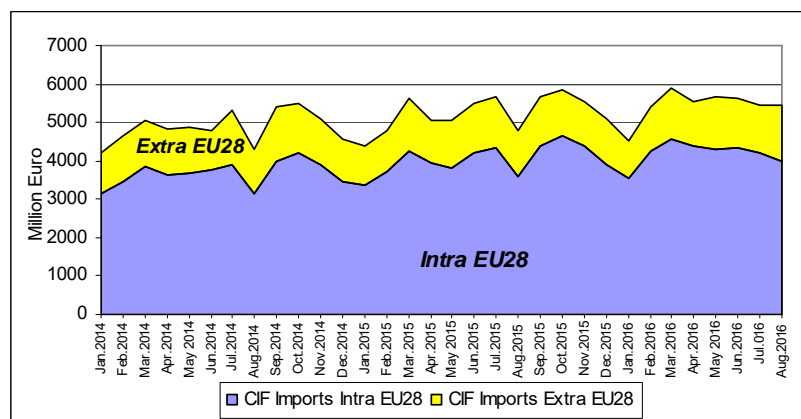
In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, the Extra-community trade of goods (Extra-EU28) amounted to 9366.9 million euro for exports and to 9965.7 million euro for imports, representing 25.0% of the total exports and 22.9% of the total imports.

INTRA – EU28 and EXTRA – EU28 exports during January 2014 – August 2016



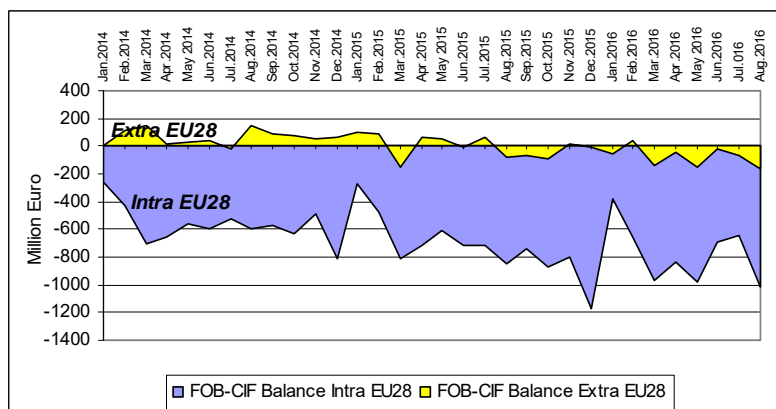

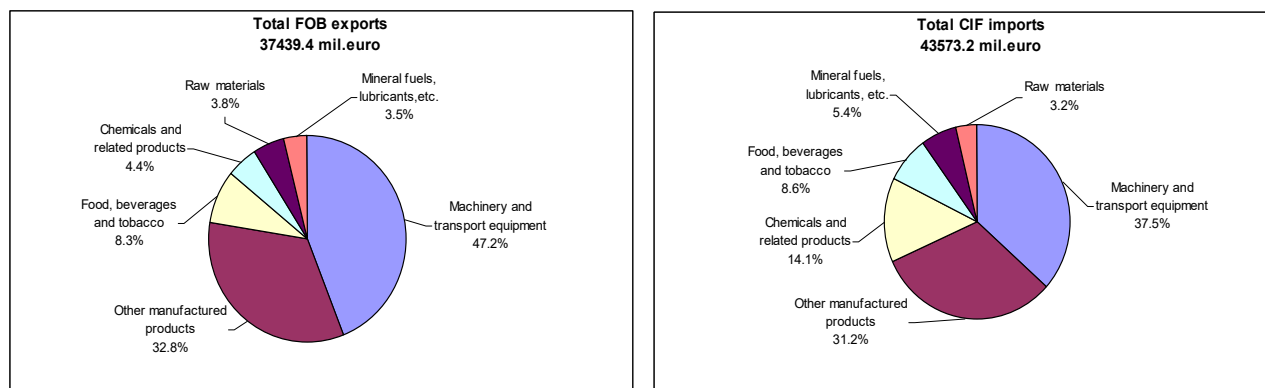
FOB-CIF balance for INTRA – EU28 and EXTRA – EU28 during January 2014 – August 2016

In the period 1.I-31.VIII 2016, important weights in the structure of exports and imports are represented by the following groups of goods: machinery and transport equipment (47.2% for export and 37.5% for import) and other manufactured goods*) (32.8% for export and 31.2% for import, respectively).
