



Domain: International trade with goods

In the year 2016, the exports and imports increased by 5.1% and by 7.0%, respectively, compared to the year 2015

- In the year 2016, the FOB exports amounted to 57385.3 million euro and the CIF imports amounted to 67342.1 million euro.
- In the year 2016, the FOB-CIF commercial deficit was of 9956.8 million euro, 1590.8 million euro more than in the year 2015.
- In December 2016, the FOB exports were of 4311.1 million euro and the CIF imports were of 5496.5 million euro, a commercial deficit of 1185.4 million euro being registered.
- Compared to December 2015, the exports increased by 9.4% and the imports increased by 7.5% in December 2016.





In the year 2016, the Intra-community trade of goods (Intra-EU28) amounted to 43078.5 million euro for dispatches and to 51948.2 million euro for arrivals, representing 75.1% of the total exports and 77.1% of the total imports.


In the year 2016, the Extra-community trade of goods (Extra-EU28) amounted to 14306.8 million euro for exports and to 15393.9 million euro for imports, representing 24.9% of the total exports and 22.9% of the total imports.

INTRA - EU28 and EXTRA - EU28 exports during January 2014 - December 2016






FOB-CIF balance for INTRA - EU28 and EXTRA - EU28 during January 2014 - December 2016



In the year 2016, important weights in the structure of exports and imports are represented by the following groups of goods: machinery and transport equipment (47.0% for export and 38.0% for import) and other manufactured goods* (32.4% for export and 31.0% for import, respectively).
