## In February 2016, the turnover of the market services rendered mainly to enterprises increased by 9.8% compared to February 2015

- Compared to the previous month, in February 2016, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by **8.6%** and as adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality by **4.7%**.
- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by **9.8%** and as adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality by **11.1%**.
- Compared to the period 1.I-28.II.2015, in the period 1.I-29.II.2016, , **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by **7.7%** and as adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality by **8.8%**.


**Monthly evolution of the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises,**

### February 2016 compared to January 2016

Compared to the previous month, in February 2016, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, gross series, increased in nominal terms by 8.6% due to rises in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release (+23.3%), in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+18.2%), in transports (+15.0%), in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (+3.1%) and in communications (+1.1%).

Compared to the previous month, in February 2016, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality, in nominal terms, globally increased by 4.7% due to rises in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release (+16.6%), in transports (+7.9%) and in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+2.5%). There were drops in communications (-2.6%) and in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (-0.9%).

### February 2016 compared to February 2015

Compared to February 2015, in February 2016, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, gross series, in nominal terms, globally increased by 9.8% due to rises in transports (+18.8%), in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+6.8%), in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (+5.5%), in communications (+2.9%) and in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release (+1.9%).

Compared to February 2015, in February 2016, **the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality, in nominal terms, globally increased by 11.1% due to rises in transports (+15.5%), in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (+5.7%), in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release (+4.8%), in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+2.3%) and in communications (+1.8%).

### **Period 1.I-29.II.2016 compared to period 1.I-28.II.2015**

Compared to the period **1.I-28.II.2015**, in the period **1.I-29.II.2016, the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, gross series, in nominal terms, globally increased by 7.7% due to rises in transports (+12.0%), in communications (+6.4%), in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (+6.3%) and in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+0.7%). There was a decrease of 0.6% in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release.

Compared to the period **1.I-28.II.2015, the turnover of market services rendered mainly to enterprises**, adjusted series by the number of working days and seasonality, in nominal terms, globally increased by 8.8% due to rises in transports (+10.7%), in other services rendered mainly to enterprises (+6.3%), in communications (+5.6%), in the activities of information services and activities of IT services (+2.7%) and in the activities of cinema, video and television programs production; programs transmission and release (+1.3%).
