



The retail turnover in July 2020

- Compared to the previous month, in July 2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles) increased both as gross series by 10.3% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 3.9%.
- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles) increased both as gross series by 4.7% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 4.2%.
- Compared to the period 1.I-31.VII.2019, in the period 1.I-31.VII.2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles) increased both as gross series by 1.2% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 0.8%.

July 2020 as against June 2020

As against the previous month, in July 2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, globally increased by 10.3% due to increases registered by the retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores (+24.6%), the sale of non-food products (+6.9%) and by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+6.3%).

As against the previous month, in July 2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, globally increased by 3.9% due to increases registered by the retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores (+9.0%), by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+2.4%) and by the sale of non-food products (+1.8%).

July 2020 as against July 2019

As against July 2019, in July 2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, globally increased by 4.7% due to increases registered by the sale of non-food products (+10.6%) and by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+4.3%). The retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores decreased by 3.7%.

As against July 2019, in July 2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, globally increased by 4.2% due to the increases registered by the sale of non-food products (+10.3%) and by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+5.9%). The retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores decreased by 4.1%.

Period 1.I-31.VII.2020 as against period 1.I-31.VII.2019

As against period 1.I-31.VII.2019, in the period 1.I-31.VII.2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, registered an increase of 1.2% due to the increases registered by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+7.1%) and by the sale of non-food products (+1.9%). The retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores decreased by 9.5%.

As against period 1.I-31.VII.2019, in the period 1.I-31.VII.2020 the retail turnover volume (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, registered an increase of 0.8% due to the increases registered by the sale of food, beverages and tobacco (+6.5%) and by the sale of non-food products (+2.0%). The retail of automotive fuel in specialised stores decreased by 9.1%.

- ✓ The information in this press release (July 2020) capture the impact of the COVID-19 crisis and of the measures taken by the authorities following the state of emergency decree on the Romanian territory starting with March 16, 2020 and the state of alert starting with May 17;

Additional information:

- ✓ The turnover represents the total revenue recorded by the company during the reporting period, obtained from both the main activity and the secondary activities performed by them. The turnover does not include VAT and the revenue from the sale or transfer of assets.
- ✓ The turnover volume indices of the retail are Laspeyres type indices and are calculated under comparable prices and methodological conditions. For expressing the values of the current period in prices of the reference period, the deflating price indices are used (consumer price index). The first indices obtained are at the level of class/group CANE Rev. 2, then, by successive aggregations, indices at aggregated levels are obtained. The weights used for aggregation are calculated based on the turnover according to the results of the Business Structural Survey from the reference year (2015).
- ✓ The response rate to the monthly statistical survey on short-term indicators in services (SERV TS), turnover chapter (CANE 47), was 81.2% in July 2020 compared to 84.5% in July 2019.
