

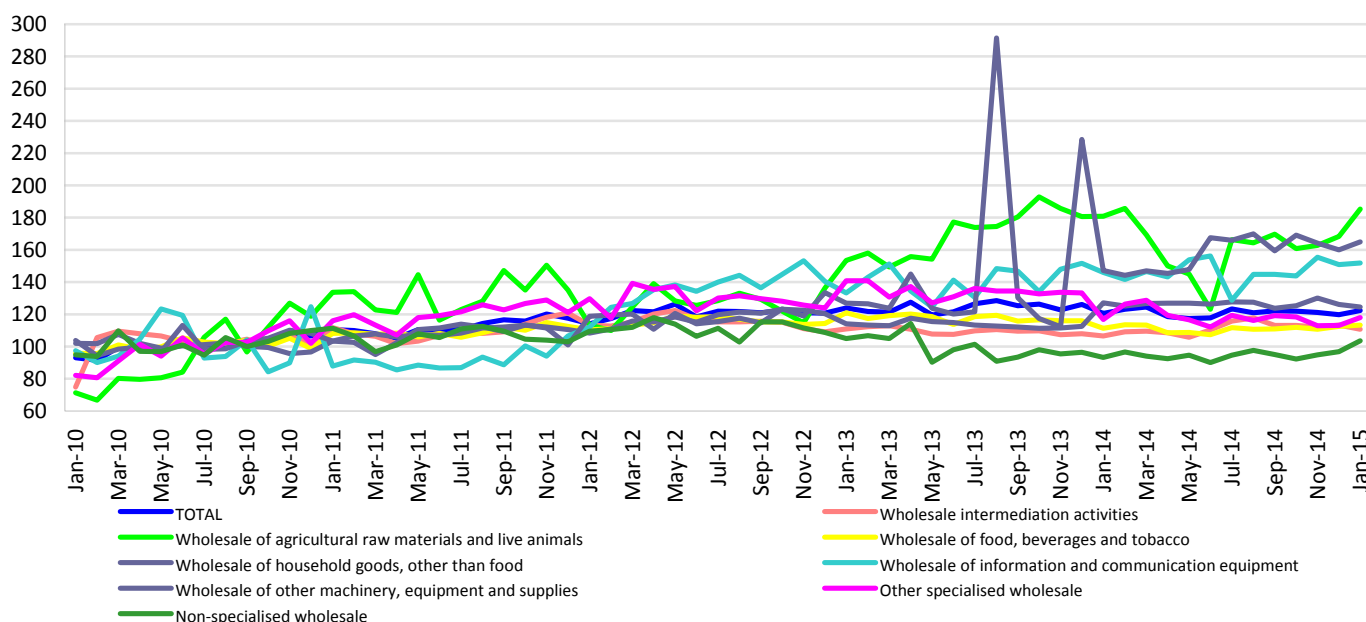

THE WHOLESALE TURNOVER INCREASED BY 1.1%

- As against the previous month, in January 2015 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, decreased as gross series by **19.1%** and increased as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **2.2%**.
- As against the corresponding month of the previous year, **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **1.1%** and by **1.5%**, respectively.

January 2015 as against December 2014

As against the previous month, in January 2015 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motor cycles), gross series, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 19.1% due to the drops registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-33.5%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-30.2%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-26.8%), by the non-specialised wholesale (-19.4%), by the wholesale of households goods, other than food (-17.2%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (-11.3%), by the other specialised wholesale (-10.0%) and by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-8.2%).

As against the previous month, in January 2015 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motor cycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, increased by 2.2% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+10.1%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+6.9%), by the other specialised wholesale (+4.3%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+3.0%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+0.8%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+0.7%). Drops were registered by the wholesale intermediation activities (-2.2%) and by the wholesale of households goods, other than food (-1.2%).

January 2015 as against January 2014

As against January 2014, in January 2015 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 1.1% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+9.0%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+8.9%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+8.4%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (+3.0%) and by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+1.1%). Drops were registered by the wholesale of households goods, other than food (-4.4%), by the other specialised wholesale (-0.3%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-0.1%).

As against January 2014, in January 2015 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 1.5% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+12.1%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+11.0%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+4.1%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (+3.9%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+2.5%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+1.8%) and by the other specialised wholesale (+0.9%). The wholesale of households goods, other than food decreased by 2.0%.
