

Domain: Trade - services

In January 2016, the wholesale turnover increased by 2.4% compared to January 2015

- As against the previous month, in January 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, decreased both as gross series by **25.5%** and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **2.6%**.
- As against the corresponding month of the previous year, **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by **2.4%** and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **2.1%**.

-2010=100 -

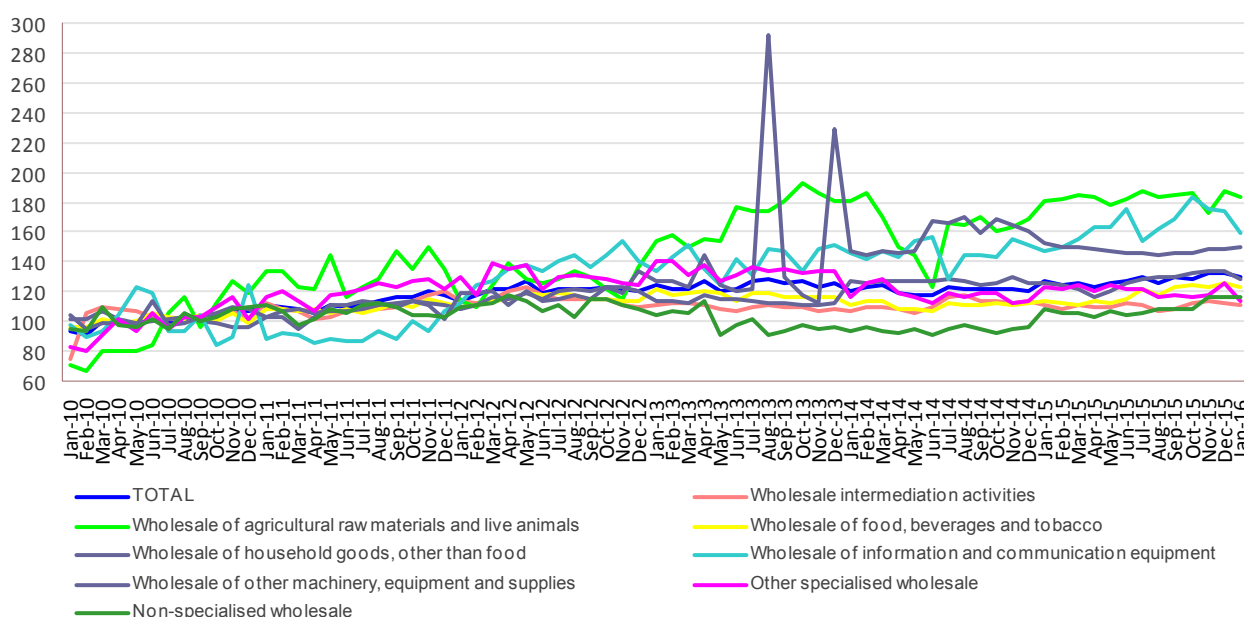

January 2016 as against December 2015

As against the previous month, in January 2016 the **wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 25.5% due to the drops registered by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-42.7%), by the non-specialised wholesale (-28.7%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-28.0%), by the other specialised wholesale (-26.8%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-20.8%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-20.6%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-20.1%) and by the wholesale intermediation activities (-16.8%).

As against the previous month, in January 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 2.6% due to the drops registered by the other specialised wholesale (-9.6%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-8.4%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-3.8%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-2.3%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-1.6%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (-1.3%) and by the non-specialised wholesale (-1.0%). The wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies increased by 1.3%.

January 2016 as against January 2015

As against January 2015, in January 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 2.4% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+11.6%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+8.2%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+7.4%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+5.1%) and by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+2.5%). Drops were registered by the other specialised wholesale (-8.9%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (-2.3%) and by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-1.4%).

As against January 2015, in January 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 2.1% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+9.0%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+7.6%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+8.3%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+2.3%) and by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+1.0%). Drops were registered by the other specialised wholesale (-8.3%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-1.4%) and by the wholesale intermediation activities (-0.7%).
