



Domain: Trade - services

In January 2017, the wholesale turnover increased by 4.2% compared to January 2016

- As against the previous month, in January 2017 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), in nominal terms, decreased both as gross series by 24.9% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 0.7%.
- As against the corresponding month of the previous year, the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by 4.2% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 5.6%.



January 2017 as against December 2016

As against the previous month, in January 2017 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 24.9% due to the drops registered by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-40.6%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-36.9%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-27.5%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-26.6%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-22.9%), by the non-specialised wholesale (-22.2%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (-20.7%) and by the other specialised wholesale (-14.8%).

As against the previous month, in January 2017 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 0.7% due to the drops registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-13.2%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-12.5%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-8.8%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-5.1%) and by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-1.8%). Increases were registered by the non-specialised wholesale (+6.5%), by the other specialised wholesale (+3.2%) and by the wholesale intermediation activities (+0.6%).

January 2017 as against January 2016

As against January 2016, in January 2017 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 4.2% due to the increments registered by the other specialised wholesale (+12.6%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+8.1%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+7.5%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+3.1%) and by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+2.2%). Drops were registered by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-3.5%), by the wholesale intermediation activities (-2.3%) and by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-1.8%).

As against January 2016, in January 2017 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 5.6% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+15.0%), by the other specialised wholesale (+11.3%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+7.4%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+7.2%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+4.3%) and by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+4.0%). Drops were registered by the wholesale intermediation activities (-2.2%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-1.9%).
