The wholesale turnover in November 2019

- As against the previous month, in November 2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), in nominal terms, decreased both as gross series by 9.0% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 0.6%.
- As against the corresponding month of the previous year, the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by 5.1% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 5.6%.
- As against period 1.I-30.XI.2018, in the period 1.I-30.XI.2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by 5.5% and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by 6.2%.



November 2019 as against October 2019

As against the previous month, in November 2019 the **wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 9.0% due to turnover drops in: the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-28.6%), the other specialised wholesale (-12.3%), the non-specialised wholesale (-7.6%), the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (-6.7%), the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-5.9%), the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-3.6%) and in the wholesale intermediation activities (-1.7%). The wholesale of information and communication equipment increased by 2.8%.

As against the previous month, in November 2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 0.6%.

November 2019 as against November 2018

As against November 2018, in November 2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), gross series, in nominal terms, globally increased by 5.1% due to the rises registered by the non-specialised wholesale (+13.1%), by the other specialised wholesale (+10.2%), by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+8.9%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+6.4%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+5.1%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+3.5%) and by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+0.7%). The turnover in the wholesale intermediation activities decreased by 21.5%.

As against November 2018, in November 2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally increased by 5.6%.

Period 1.I-30.XI.2019 as against period 1.I-30.XI.2018

As against period 1.I-30.XI.2018, in the period 1.I-30.XI.2019 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 5.5% due to turnover rises in: the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+11.4%), the non-specialised wholesale (+10.6%), the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+9.8%), the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+9.6%), the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+5.9%), the other specialised wholesale (+3.2%) and in the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+0.5%). The turnover in the wholesale intermediation activities decreased by 12.4%.

As against period 1.I-30.XI.2018, in the period 1.I-30.XI.2019 the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles), adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally increased by 6.2%.

Additional information:

- ✓ The turnover represents the total revenue recorded by the company during the reporting period, obtained from both the main activity and the secondary activities performed by them. The turnover does not include VAT and the revenue from the sale or transfer of assets.
- ✓ The turnover volume indices of the retail are Laspeyres type indices. The first indices obtained are at the level of CANE Rev. 2 group, then, by aggregations, indices at total level are obtained. The weights used for aggregation are calculated based on the turnover according to the results of the Business Structural Survey from the reference year (2015).
