

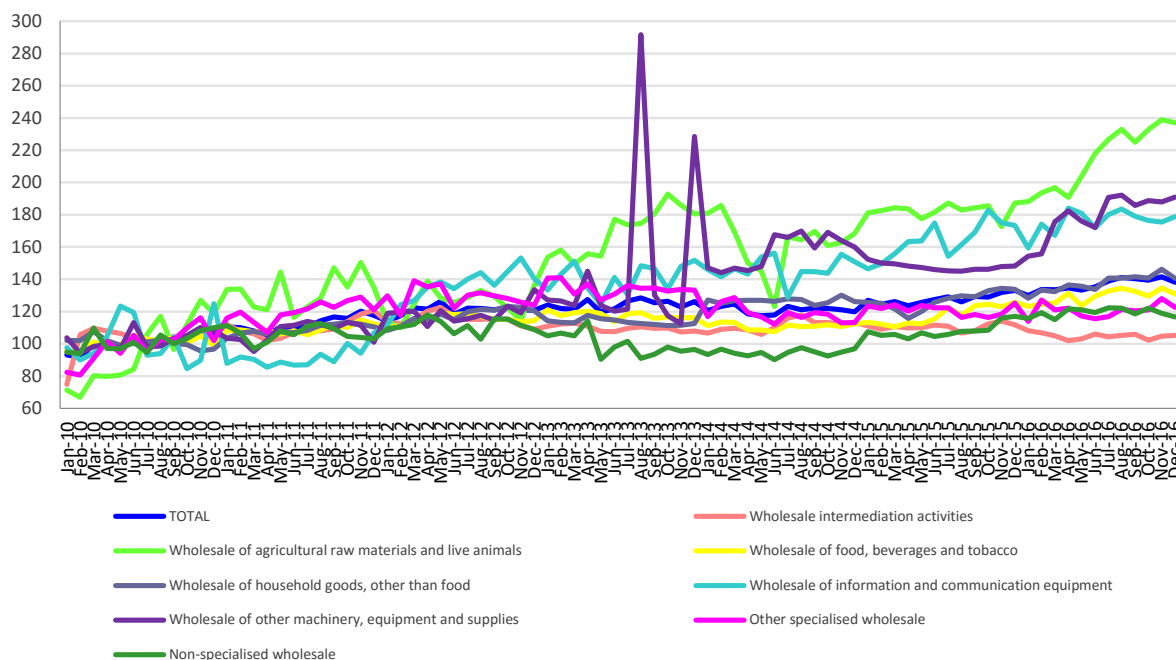
Domain: Trade - services

In 2016, the wholesale turnover increased by 7.7% compared to 2015

- As against the previous month, in December 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, decreased both as gross series by **6.2%** and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **2.3%**.
- As against the corresponding month of the previous year, **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, increased both as gross series by **2.8%** and as adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality by **3.8%**.
- As against 2015, in 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, in nominal terms, increased as gross series by **7.7%**.

December 2016 as against November 2016

As against the previous month, in December 2016 the **wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 6.2% due to the drops registered by the other specialised wholesale (-22.8%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals and by the non-specialised wholesale (-6.9% each), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-6.4%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-4.6%). Increases were registered by the wholesale intermediation activities (+3.3%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+3.0%) and by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+0.4%).

As against the previous month, in December 2016 the **wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, globally decreased by 2.3% due to the drops registered by the other specialised wholesale (-4.2%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (-3.8%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (-2.7%), by the non-specialised wholesale (-1.9%) and by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (-0.7%). Increases were registered by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+1.9%), by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+1.6%) and by the wholesale intermediation activities (+0.3%).

December 2016 as against December 2015

As against December 2015, in December 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 2.8% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+22.6%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+17.4%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+4.3%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+2.1%) and by the wholesale intermediation activities (+1.1%). Drops were registered by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (-7.3%), by the other specialised wholesale (-3.7%) and by the non-specialised wholesale (-1.0%).

As against December 2015, in December 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 3.8% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+28.8%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+26.6%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+5.1%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+4.2%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+3.1%). Drops were registered by the wholesale intermediation activities (-6.0%), by the other specialised wholesale (-2.0%) and by the non-specialised wholesale (-0.3%).

Year 2016 as against year 2015

As against 2015, in 2016 **the wholesale turnover (excluding the trade with motor vehicles and motorcycles)**, gross series, in nominal terms, registered an increase of 7.7% due to the increments registered by the wholesale of other machinery, equipment and supplies (+25.5%), by the wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals (+19.0%), by the non-specialised wholesale (+11.0%), by the wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco (+10.1%), by the wholesale of household goods, other than food (+8.7%) and by the wholesale of information and communication equipment (+4.2%). Drops were registered by the wholesale intermediation activities (-4.1%) and by the other specialised wholesale (-0.3%).
