

By residential area, most of the dwellings were built in the urban area (584%) in Quarter I 2016

The distribution by financing funds of the completed dwellings shows that, compared to Quarter I 2015, the number of dwellings built with private funds increased by 2633 dwellings in Quarter I 2016

The regional distribution highlights an increase in the following development regions: North – East (+1211 dwellings), North - West (+496), South – East (+378), West (+244), Centre (+210), South-West Oltenia (+136), South-Muntenia (+97) There was a decrease in the number of completed dwellings in the development region Bucharest – Ilfov (-414 dwellings)
