In the first quarter of 2019, 12714 dwellings were completed, 2441 dwellings more compared to the first quarter of 2018.

Completed dwellings by area of residence and financing sources, in the first quarter of 2019 compared to the first quarter of 2018



According to the breakdown by area of residence, in the first quarter of 2019, most of the dwellings were built in the urban area (59.2%).

The distribution of the completed dwellings by financing sources shows that, in the first quarter of 2019, the number of dwellings built from private funds increased by 2368 dwellings compared to the first quarter of 2018 and the number of dwellings built from public funds rose by 73 dwellings.

The regional distribution in the first quarter of 2019 compared to the first quarter of 2018 shows an increase in the number of completed dwellings in the following development regions: Centre (+789 dwellings), Bucharest-Ilfov (+558), North-East (+379), North-West (+354), South-West Oltenia (+218), South-East (+196) and South-Muntenia (+48). In the West development region, there was a drop in the number of completed dwellings (-101 dwellings) compared to the first quarter of 2018.
