- The cattle livestock existent on June 1, 2022, compared to June 1, 2021, decreased by 0.7% per total and by 0.9% for the breeding livestock.

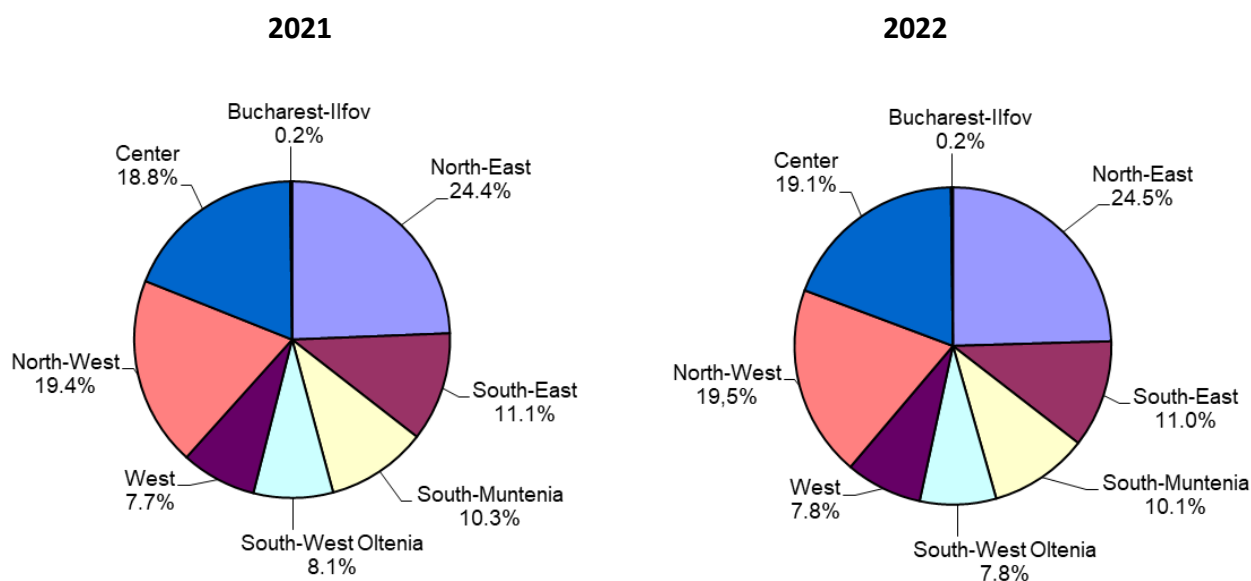

Distribution of the cattle livestock existent on June 1, by development regions

By analysing the distribution by development regions on June 1, 2022 compared to the same period of 2021, it is noticed that the share of the cattle livestock increased in the regions Centre (+0.3 percentage points), North-East, West and North-West (+0.1 pp.), decreased in the regions South-West Oltenia (-0.3 pp.), South-Muntenia (-0.2 pp.) and South-East (-0.1 pp.) and it remained constant in the Bucharest-Ilfov region.

The development regions include the following counties:

- North-East development region: Bacau, Botosani, Iasi, Neamt, Suceava and Vaslui.
- South-East development region: Braila, Buzau, Constanta, Galati, Tulcea and Vrancea.
- South-Muntenia development region: Arges, Calarasi, Dambovita, Giurgiu, Ialomita, Prahova and Teleorman.
- South-West Oltenia development region: Dolj, Gorj, Mehedinti, Olt and Valcea.
- West development region: Arad, Caras-Severin, Hunedoara and Timis.
- North-West development region: Bihor, Bistrita-Nasaud, Cluj, Maramures, Satu-Mare and Salaj.
- Centre development region: Alba, Brasov, Covasna, Harghita, Mures and Sibiu.
- Bucharest-Ilfov development region: Bucharest municipality and Ilfov county.
