

Domain: Construction

IN FEBRUARY 2016, THE CONSTRUCTION WORKS INCREASED BY 8.7% COMPARED TO FEBRUARY 2015

- In February 2016, the volume of construction works increased, both as gross series and as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality by 32.7% and by 5.1%, respectively compared to the previous month.
- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the volume of construction works increased, both as gross series and as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality by 8.7% and by 5.7%, respectively.
- Compared to the period 1.I-28.II.2015, in the period 1.I-29.II.2016, the volume of construction works increased, both as gross series and as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality by 4.3% and by 5.3%, respectively.


Monthly evolution of construction works, by structure elements,

- January 2010 – February 2016-


(adjusted series according to the number of working days and to seasonality)

February 2016 compared to January 2016

The volume of construction works increased, as gross series, by 32.7%, increase highlighted as follows: in new construction works by 39.3%, in capital repairs works by 36.0% and in maintenance and current repairs works by 14.8%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in non-residential buildings of 45.1%, in engineering works of 33.3% and in residential buildings of 9.7%.

The volume of construction works increased, as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality, by 5.1%, increase highlighted as follows: in capital repairs works of 27.3%, in new construction works of 11.4% and in maintenance and current repairs works of 7.5%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in non-residential buildings and in engineering works of 25.5% and of 1.9%, respectively. There was a decrease of 0.3% in residential buildings.

February 2016 compared to February 2015

The volume of construction works increased, as gross series, by 8.7%. By structure elements there were rises as follows: in capital repairs works of 37.6%, in new construction works of 7.6% and in maintenance and current repairs works of 2.0%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in non-residential buildings of 17.2%, in residential buildings of 17.0% and in engineering works of 0.6%.

The volume of construction works increased, as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality, by 5.7%. By structure elements, there were rises as follows: in capital repairs works of 57.8%, in maintenance and current repairs works of 14.8% and in new construction works of 4.2%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in residential buildings of 40.9%, in non-residential buildings of 19.1% and in engineering works of 1.5%.

Period 1.I-29.II.2016 compared to period 1.I-28.II.2015

The volume of construction works increased per total, as gross series, by 4.3%. By structure elements there were rises as follows: in maintenance and current repairs works of 10.6%, in capital repairs works of 4.2% and in new construction works of 2.2%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in residential buildings and in non-residential buildings of 13.2% and of 6.8%, respectively. There was a decrease of 0.4% in engineering works.

The volume of construction works increased per total, as adjusted series by the number of working days and by seasonality, by 5.3%. By structure elements, there were rises as follows: in capital repairs works of 20.4%, in maintenance and current repairs works of 14.7% and in new construction works of 1.2%.

By construction objects there were rises as follows: in residential buildings of 28.6%, in non-residential buildings of 6.5% and in engineering works of 5.6%.
