


Domain: Consumer prices

IN JANUARY 2019, THE ANNUAL RATE OF PRICES WAS 3.3%

- Consumer prices were up 0.8% in January 2019 compared to December 2018.
- The average consumer price rate based on the CPI over the last 12 months (February 2018-January 2019) as compared to the previous 12 months (February 2017-January 2018) is 4.5%.
