

## THE EVOLUTION OF CONSUMER PRICES IN JUNE 2020

- Consumer prices were up 2.6% in June 2020 compared to June 2019. The annual rate calculated on the basis of the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) is 2.2%.
- The average consumer price rate based on the CPI over the last 12 months (July 2019-June 2020) as compared to the previous 12 months (July 2018-June 2019) is 3.3%. The average rate based on the HICP is 3.2%.
