## INFLATION AND THE EVOLUTION OF CONSUMER PRICES: JULY 2021

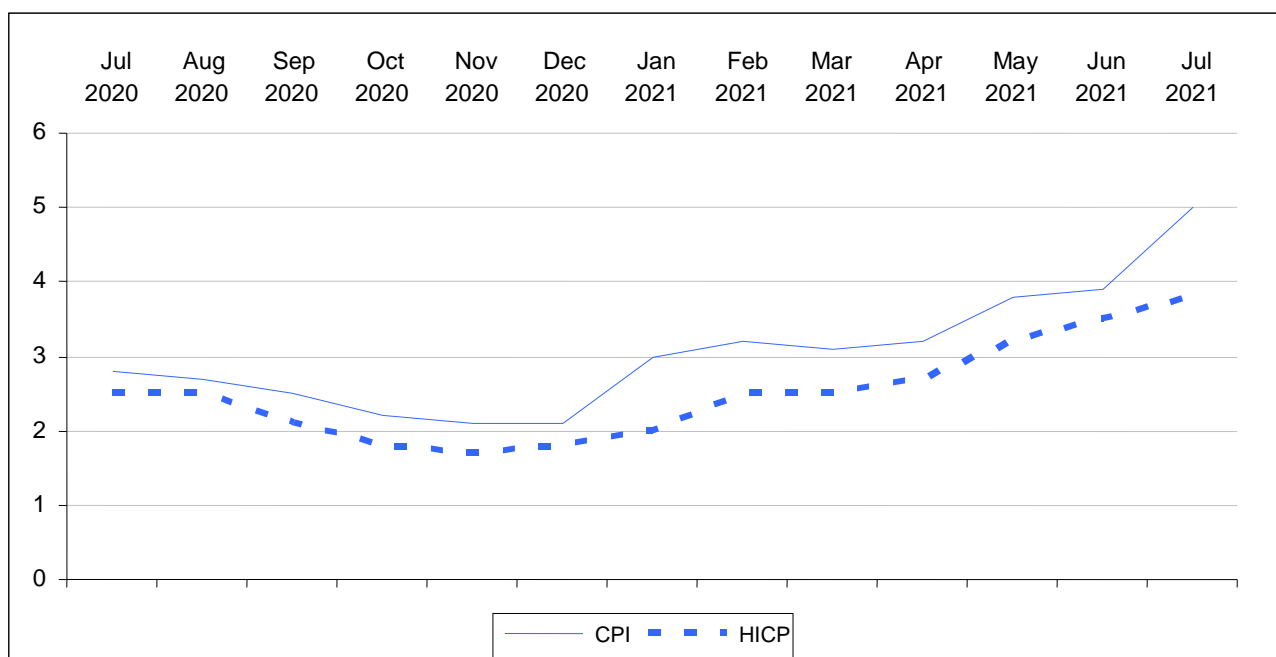
### 1. The Consumer Price Index (CPI)

- Consumer prices were up 1.0% in July 2021 from June 2021.
- The inflation rate since the beginning of the year (July 2021 compared to December 2020) is 4.4%.
- The annual inflation rate in July 2021 compared to July 2020 is 5.0%.
- The average consumer price rate over the last 12 months (August 2020-July 2021) as compared to the previous 12 months (August 2019-July 2020) is 3.1%.

### 2. The Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)

- The Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices in July 2021 compared to June 2021 is 100.46%.
- The HICP-based annual inflation rate in July 2021 compared to July 2020 is 3.8%.
- The HICP-based average consumer price rate over the last 12 months (August 2020-July 2021) as compared to the previous 12 months (August 2019-July 2020) is 2.5%.
