

THE EVOLUTION OF CONSUMER PRICES IN AUGUST 2020

- Consumer prices were up 2.7% in August 2020 compared to August 2019. The annual rate calculated on the basis of the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) is 2.5%.
- The average consumer price rate based on the CPI over the last 12 months (September 2019-August 2020) as compared to the previous 12 months (September 2018-August 2019) is 3.1%. The average rate based on the HICP is 2.9%.
