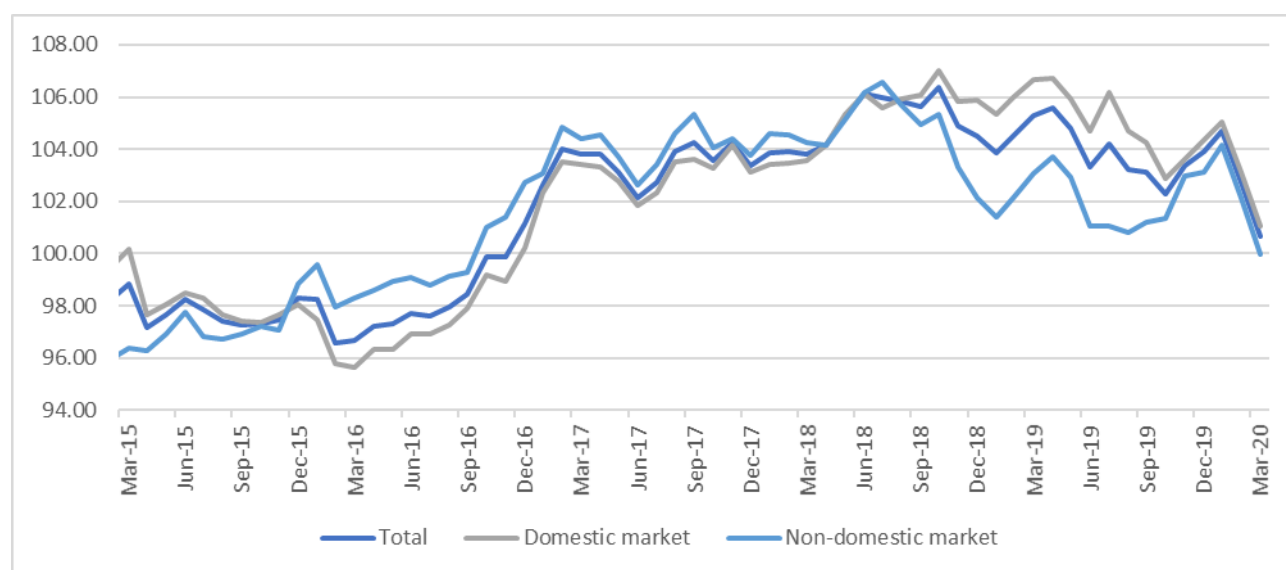


Domain: Industrial production prices

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN MARCH 2020

- In **March 2020**, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) were down 1.2% from **February 2020**.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) increased by 0.7% in **March 2020** compared to **March 2019**.
