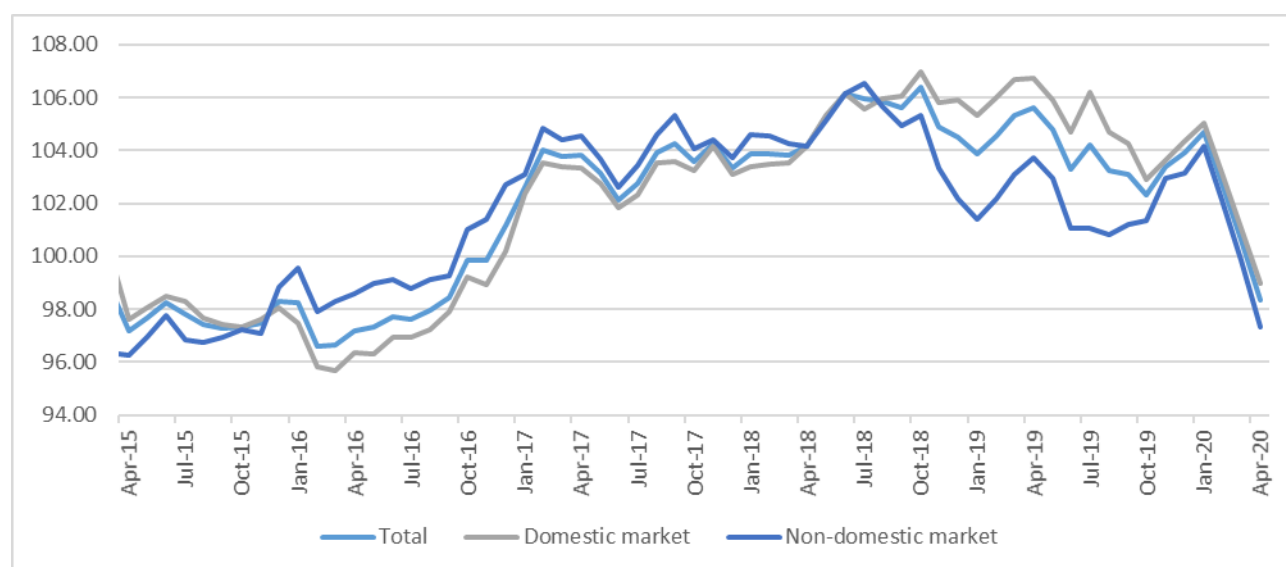


Domain: Industrial production prices

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN APRIL 2020

- In **April 2020**, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) were down 1.6% from **March 2020**.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) decreased by 1.6% in **April 2020** compared to **April 2019**.

Due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus epidemic, there were enterprises that temporarily ceased their activities, worked at a slower pace or partially changed their economic activity from the moment the government restrictions on limiting the spread of the virus were adopted.

In April 2020, the industrial production price index was calculated based on a lower number of statistical observations than usual for the following CANE Rev. 2 activities (divisions): Manufacture of textiles, Manufacture of wearing apparel, Manufacture of leather and related products, Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, Manufacture of furniture.
