

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN MAY 2025

- In May 2025, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) decreased by 0.2% compared to April 2025.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) rose by 0.9% in May 2025 compared to May 2024.
