

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN JUNE 2025

- In June 2025, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) increased by 0.1% compared to May 2025.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) fell by 0.3% in June 2025 compared to June 2024.
