

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN JULY 2020

- In **July 2020**, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) were up 0.5% from **June 2020**.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) decreased by 0.8% in July 2020 compared to July 2019.
