


Domain: Industrial production prices

THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN AUGUST 2019

- In August 2019, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) were down 0.3% from July 2019.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) increased by 3.3% in August 2019 compared to August 2018.
