

## THE EVOLUTION OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION PRICES IN AUGUST 2020

- In August 2020, industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) were down 0.2% from July 2020.
- Industrial production prices for the total (domestic market and non-domestic market) decreased by 0.7% in August 2020 compared to August 2019.
