

Transport Statistics

In Quarter I 2015, compared to Quarter I 2014, new registrations of passenger cars increased by 14.7%

- In Quarter I 2015, compared to Quarter I 2014, **the new registrations of road vehicles** ²⁾ for passenger transport increased by 14.2%,
- The new registrations of vehicles for goods transport increased by 9.6% compared to the same period of the previous year.

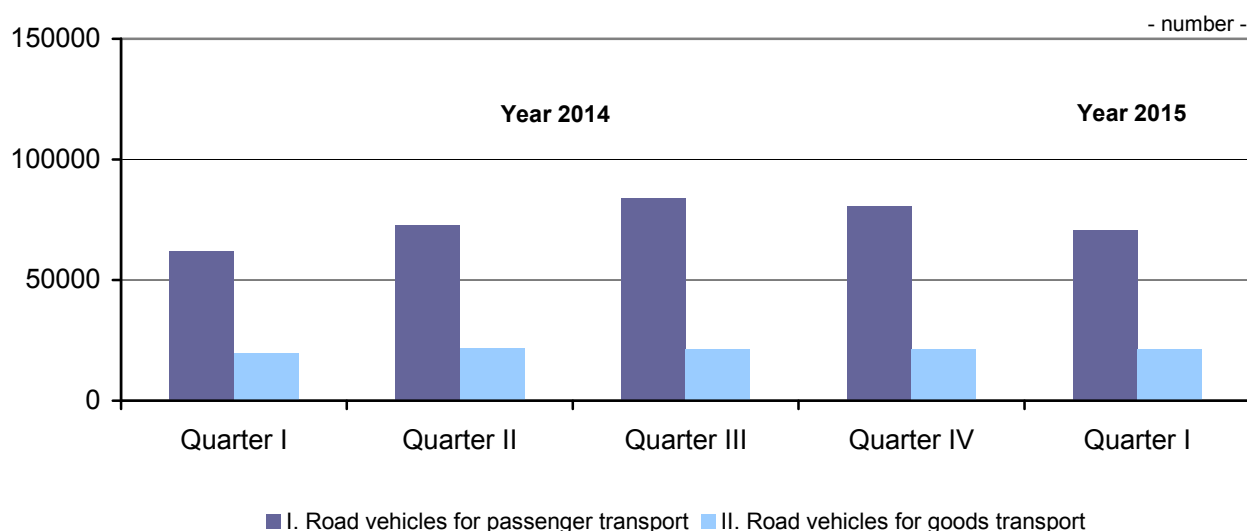

In Quarter I 2015, compared to the same quarter of 2014, the registrations of *passenger cars* increased by 14.7%. There were drops of 8.7% and of 6.0% in the categories *mopeds and motorcycles* and *buses and minibuses*, respectively.

In the same period, the new registrations of road vehicles for goods transport increased by 15.8% for *trailers and semitrailers*, by 12.1% for *road tractors* and by 6.2% for *lorries*, respectively.

Compared to Quarter IV 2014, in Quarter I 2015, the new registrations of road vehicles for passenger transport decreased by 12.5%, while the new registrations of road vehicles for goods transport increased by 0.6%.
