The new registrations*) of road vehicles, in the third quarter of 2022, and vehicles registered, at the end of the third quarter of 2022

- In the third quarter of 2022, the **new registrations of road vehicles for passenger transport****) decreased by 16.1% compared to the third quarter of 2021.
- In the same quarter of 2022, the **new registrations of road vehicles for goods transport** fell by 10.0% compared to the third quarter of 2021.
- In the third quarter of 2022, the share of the **new registrations of imported used passenger cars** in the total new registrations of passenger cars was 69.7%, a decrease of 2.5 percentage points compared to the same quarter of 2021.

In the third quarter of 2022, the **new registrations of road vehicles for passenger transport** increased for *mopeds and motorcycles* (+20.7%) and for *buses and minibuses* (+11.5%) and decreased for *passenger cars* (-17.3%) compared to the third quarter of 2021. With regard to the **new registrations of new road vehicles for passenger transport**, rises were reported for *mopeds and motorcycles* (+30.4%) and *buses and minibuses* (+6.2%), and a drop was recorded for *passenger cars* (-9.9%).



As regards the **new registrations of road vehicles for goods transport**, falls were reported for all categories, namely: *lorries* (*special purpose road vehicles* included) (-16.0%), *trailers and semitrailers* (-3.3%) and *road tractors* (-2.5%). The **new registrations of new road vehicles for goods transport** increased for *road tractors* (+55.8%) and decreased for *lorries* (*special purpose road vehicles* included) (-18.4%) and *trailers and semitrailers* (-9.8%).

In the third quarter of 2022, the new registrations of road vehicles for passenger transport rose by 5.3% compared to the second quarter of 2022 and the new registrations of road vehicles for goods transport fell by 4.6%.

At the end of the third quarter of 2022, 59.2% of the road vehicles registered classified according to the European emissions standards were Euro 4, Euro 5 or Euro 6 vehicles and 11.6% were Non-Euro vehicles.

Within the *passenger cars* category, the highest share was that of Euro 4 vehicles, namely 35.0%; within the *buses and minibuses* category, the greatest number of vehicles (namely 25.2%) were Euro 3 vehicles; as regards the *mopeds and motorcycles*, the greatest number of vehicles within this category (namely 28.1%) were classified as Non-Euro.

The Euro 3 vehicles prevailed within the *lorries* category (29.5%), the Euro 6 vehicles prevailed within the *road* tractors category (36.3%), and the greatest number of vehicles within the category of *special purpose road* vehicles (namely 25.1%) were classified as Non-Euro.

Additional information:

The new registrations of road vehicles comprise the registrations of new vehicles, including those of lease-purchased vehicles, as well as the registrations of imported used vehicles, classified according to the Community vehicle categories.

The re-registrations due to change of owner as a consequence of the sale of the motor vehicle are not included. Trams and trolleybuses, military vehicles, agricultural trailers and housing vehicles are also not included.

The vehicles registered, at the end of the reference quarter, present provisional data on the registered road vehicles classified according to the European vehicle emissions standards. Three- and four-wheeled motorcycles are included under the "mopeds and motorcycles" category. The special purpose road vehicles include fire brigade vehicles, mobile cranes etc.

The data do not include the road vehicles to which the European vehicle emissions standards are not applicable, namely tractors, trailers and semitrailers.
