The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in February 2018 up 8.3% from February 2017

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in February 2018 decreased by 6.0% compared to January 2018 and was up 8.3% from February 2017.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres increased by 10.4% in the period 1.I-28.II.2018 compared to the period 1.I-28.II.2017.

February 2018 compared to January 2018

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units decreased by 4875 tonnes (-6.0%) in February 2018 compared to the previous month.

Likewise, decreases in production in February 2018 compared to January 2018 were recorded for: acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products) with 2393 tonnes (-12.1%), cheese products with 716 tonnes (-9.7%), drinking milk with 2279 tonnes (-8.5%), cream with 332 tonnes (-5.9%) and butter with 42 tonnes (-4.9%).

The quantity of imported raw milk decreased by 3858 tonnes (-22.6%) in February 2018 compared to January 2018.

February 2018 compared to February 2017

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in February 2018 was up 5921 tonnes (+8.3%) from the same month of the previous year.

The production increased for drinking milk with 838 tonnes (+3.5%) and for acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products) with 407 tonnes (+2.4%).

The production decreased for butter with 212 tonnes (-20.6%), cheese products with 64 tonnes (-1.0%) and for cream with 11 tonnes (-0.2%).

The quantity of imported raw milk decreased in February 2018 with 64 tonnes (-0.5%) compared to the same month of the previous year.

Period 1.I-28.II.2018 compared to the period 1.I-28.II.2017


In the period 1.I-28.II.2018, compared to the period 1.I-28.II.2017, the quantity of cow's milk collected by the processing units increased by 14980 tonnes (+10.4%).

In the period 1.I-28.II.2018 compared to the same period of the previous year, the production increased for: cheese products with 1072 tonnes (+8.3%), acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products) with 2551 tonnes (+7.3%), drinking milk with 1220 tonnes (+2.4%) and cream with 235 tonnes (+2.2%).

The butter production decreased with 394 tonnes (-19.0%).

The quantity of imported raw milk increased with 2437 tonnes (+8.7%) in the period 1.I-28.II.2018 compared to period 1.I-28.II.2017.
