The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in February 2019

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in February 2019 decreased by 5.1% compared to January 2019 and was up 7.2% from February 2018.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in the 1.I-28.II.2019 period rose by 6.4% compared to the 1.I-28.II.2018 period.

February 2019 compared to January 2019

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in February 2019 fell by 4384 tonnes (-5.1%) compared to the previous month.

Decreases in production were recorded for the following milk products: butter, with 130 less tonnes produced (-13.3%) in February 2019 than in January 2019, acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1545 less tonnes produced (-7.7%), cream, for which a 441 tonne fall (-7.5%) was reported, and cheese products, for which a 216 tonne fall (-3.0%) was reported.

The production of drinking milk increased by 1868 tonnes (+7.1%).

The quantity of imported raw milk decreased by 257 tonnes (-2.5%) in February 2019 compared to the previous month.

February 2019 compared to February 2018

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in February 2019 was up 5501 tonnes (+7.2%) from the same month of the previous year.

Increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, for which a 3842 tonne rise (+15.7%) was reported, acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1138 more tonnes produced (+6.5%), cheese products, for which a 326 tonne rise (+4.9%) was reported, butter, for which a 34 tonne rise (+4.2%) was reported, and cream, with 190 more tonnes produced (+3.6%).

The quantity of imported raw milk decreased by 3236 tonnes (-24.5%) in February 2019 compared to the same month of the previous year.


The 1.I-28.II.2019 period compared to the 1.I-28.II.2018 period

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in the 1.I-28.II.2019 period rose by 10234 tonnes (+6.4%) compared to the 1.I-28.II.2018 period.

Increases in production were recorded for butter, with 156 more tonnes produced (+9.3%), drinking milk, for which a 3537 tonne rise (+6.9%) was reported, cream, for which a 489 tonne rise (+4.5%) was reported, acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1428 more tonnes produced (+3.8%), and cheese products, with 150 more tonnes produced (+1.1%).

The quantity of imported raw milk was down 10073 tonnes (-33.2%) in the 1.I-28.II.2019 period from the 1.I-28.II.2018 period.
