The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2018

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in June 2018 decreased by 5.8% compared to May 2018 and was up 2.5% from June 2017.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period rose by 7.4% compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2017 period.

June 2018 compared to May 2018

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2018 fell by 6411 tonnes (-5.8%) compared to the previous month.

Decreases in production were recorded for cheese products, with 1441 less tonnes produced (-14.2%) in June 2018 than in May 2018, followed by drinking milk, for which a 3621 tonne fall (-13.7%) was reported, butter, with 121 less tonnes produced (-13.6%), cream, for which a 428 tonne fall (-7.6%) was reported, and acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1317 less tonnes produced (-7.0%).

The quantity of imported raw milk decreased by 3196 tonnes (-32.4%) in June 2018 compared to the previous month.

June 2018 compared to June 2017

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2018 was up 2577 tonnes (+2.5%) from the same month of the previous year.

Increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, with 827 more tonnes produced (+3.8%), cream, for which a 74 tonne rise (+1.4%) was reported, and acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 218 more tonnes produced (+1.3%).

Decreases in production were recorded for butter, for which a 75 tonne fall (-8.9%) was reported, and cheese products, with 203 less tonnes produced (-2.3%).

The quantity of imported raw milk increased by 326 tonnes (+5.1%) in June 2018 compared to the same month of the previous year.

The 1.I-30.VI.2018 period compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2017 period

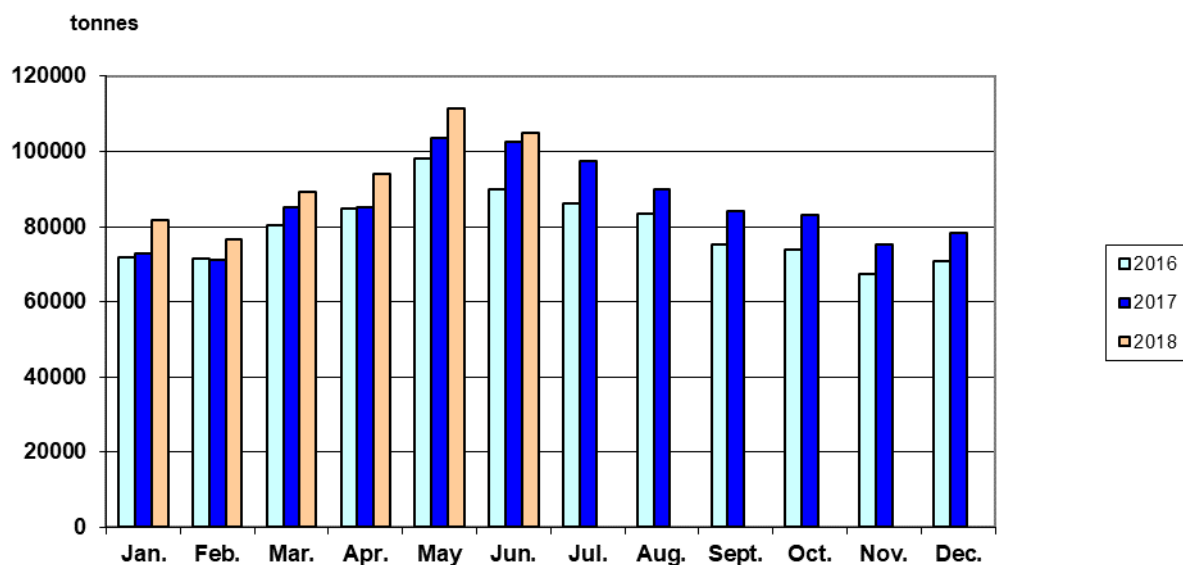
The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period rose by 38623 tonnes (+7.4%) compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2017 period.

Increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, for which a 6789 tonne rise (+4.7%) was reported, cheese products, with 1903 more tonnes produced (+4.1%), acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1573 more tonnes produced (+1.5%), and cream, for which a 338 tonne rise (+1.1%) was reported.

The production of butter decreased by 931 tonnes (-15.1%).

The quantity of imported raw milk was up 2506 tonnes (+3.7%) in the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period from the 1.I-30.VI.2017 period.
