The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2019

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in June 2019 decreased by 6.8% compared to May 2019 and was down 0.8% from June 2018.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in the 1.I-30.VI.2019 period rose by 4.2% compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period.

June 2019 compared to May 2019

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2019 fell by 7626 tonnes (-6.8%) compared to the previous month.

^{**)} Due to rounding and the revision of the monthly data, the data related to the cumulated periods may differ from the ones resulting from summing up the months.

Decreases in production were recorded for the following milk products in June 2019 compared to May 2019: acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), for which a 3518 tonne drop (-16.9%) was reported, drinking milk, with 3782 less tonnes produced (-13.7%), cheese products, for which a 721 tonne drop (-7.3%) was reported, cream, with 327 less tonnes produced (-5.5%), and butter, for which a 24 tonne drop (-3.1%) was reported.

The quantity of raw milk imported by processing units decreased by 704 tonnes (-10.5%) in June 2019 compared to the previous month.

June 2019 compared to June 2018

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in June 2019 was down 878 tonnes (-0.8%) from the same month of the previous year.

Decreases in production were recorded for butter, for which a 10 tonne drop (-1.3%) was reported, and acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 123 less tonnes produced (-0.7%).

Increases in production were recorded for cream, with 391 more tonnes produced (+7.5%), cheese products, for which a 458 tonne rise (+5.2%) was reported, and drinking milk, with 943 more tonnes produced (+4.1%).

The quantity of raw milk imported by processing units was down 655 tonnes (-9.8%) in June 2019 from the same month of the previous year.

The 1.I-30.VI.2019 period compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in the 1.I-30.VI.2019 period rose by 23257 tonnes (+4.2%) compared to the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period.

Increases in production in the 1.I-30.VI.2019 period compared to the same period of the previous year were recorded for: drinking milk, with 11013 more tonnes produced (+7.3%), acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), for which a 6812 tonne rise (+6.4%) was reported, cream, with 1499 more tonnes produced (+4.6%), cheese products, for which a 954 tonne rise (+2.0%) was reported, and butter, with 52 more tonnes produced (+1.0%).

The quantity of raw milk imported by processing units was down 19012 tonnes (-27.3%) in the 1.I-30.VI.2019 period from the 1.I-30.VI.2018 period.
