The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in July 2018

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in July 2018 increased by 1.6% compared to June 2018 and was up 9.6% from July 2017.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in the 1.I-31.VII.2018 period rose by 7.8% compared to the 1.I-31.VII.2017 period.

July 2018 compared to June 2018

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in July 2018 rose by 1662 tonnes (+1.6%) compared to the previous month.

Increases in production were recorded for butter, with 157 more tonnes produced (+20.4%) in July 2018 than in June 2018, followed by cream, for which a 589 tonne rise (+11.3%) was reported, acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), for which a 654 tonne rise (+3.7%) was reported, cheese products, with 163 more tonnes produced (+1.9%), and drinking milk, with 219 more tonnes produced (+1.0%).

The quantity of imported raw milk increased by 143 tonnes (+2.1%) in July 2018 compared to the previous month.

July 2018 compared to July 2017

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in July 2018 was up 9384 tonnes (+9.6%) from the same month of the previous year.

Increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, with 4110 more tonnes produced (+21.6%), butter, for which a 73 tonne rise (+8.5%) was reported, cream, with 298 more tonnes produced (+5.4%), and cheese products, for which a 324 tonne rise (+3.8%) was reported.

A decrease in production was recorded for acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 33 less tonnes produced (-0.2%).

The quantity of imported raw milk increased by 1219 tonnes (+21.8%) in July 2018 compared to the same month of the previous year.

The 1.I-31.VII.2018 period compared to the 1.I-31.VII.2017 period


The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in the 1.I-31.VII.2018 period rose by 48007 tonnes (+7.8%) compared to the 1.I-31.VII.2017 period.

Increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, with 10899 more tonnes produced (+6.6%), cheese products, for which a 2228 tonne rise (+4.0%) was reported, cream, for which a 636 tonne rise (+1.7%) was reported, and acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and other similar milk products), with 1539 more tonnes produced (+1.3%).

The production of butter decreased by 858 tonnes (-12.2%).

The quantity of imported raw milk was up 3725 tonnes (+5.1%) in the 1.I-31.VII.2018 period from the 1.I-31.VII.2017 period.
