The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units down 11.2%

- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in August 2015 decreased by 8.9% compared to July 2015 and was down 11.2% from August 2014.
- The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units from agricultural holdings and collection centres in the 1.I-31.VIII.2015 period dropped 8.6% compared to the 1.I-31.VIII.2014 period.

August 2015 compared to July 2015

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in August 2015 decreased by 7732 tonnes (-8.9%) compared to the previous month.

Decreases in production were recorded for cheese products, including the cheese obtained exclusively from cow's milk (83.9% of the total production of cheese products), with 1649 less tonnes produced (-19.0%) in August 2015 than the previous month, butter, for which a 52 tonne fall (-6.4%) was reported, and acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and others), with 91 less tonnes produced (-0.5%).

Of the main milk products, increases in production were recorded for drinking milk, for which a 2682 tonne rise (+16.0%) was reported, and cream, with 197 more tonnes produced (+3.6%) in August 2015 than in July 2015.

The quantity of imported raw milk increased by 721 tonnes (+12.5%) in August 2015 compared to July 2015.

August 2015 compared to August 2014

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in August 2015 was down 9989 tonnes (-11.2%) from the same month of the previous year.

Of the main milk products, a decrease in production was recorded for butter, with 38 less tonnes produced (-4.7%) in August 2015 than in the same month of 2014.

The milk products whose production increased in August 2015 compared to August 2014 were: cream, with 849 more tonnes produced (+17.7%), acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt, curd and others), for which a 2391 tonne rise (+16.7%) was reported, drinking milk, with 1612 more tonnes produced (+9.1%), and cheese products, including the cheese obtained exclusively from cow's milk, for which a 583 tonne rise (+9.0%) was reported.

The quantity of imported raw milk was up 1894 tonnes (+41.3%) in August 2015 from August 2014.


The 1.I-31.VIII.2015 period compared to the 1.I-31.VIII.2014 period

The quantity of cow's milk collected by processing units in the 1.I-31.VIII.2015 period decreased by 59239 tonnes (-8.6%) compared to the 1.I-31.VIII.2014 period.

The following increases in production were recorded for the main milk products in the 1.I-31.VIII.2015 period compared to the 1.I-31.VIII.2014 period: 5111 tonnes (+13.4%) for cream, 9952 tonnes (+8.5%) for acidified milk (yogurt, drinking yogurt and others), 3501 tonnes (+6.5%) for cheese products, including the cheese obtained exclusively from cow's milk (81.9% of the total production of cheese products), 3098 tonnes (+1.9%) for drinking milk, and 34 tonnes (+0.5%) for butter.

The quantity of imported raw milk was up 2327 tonnes (+4.4%) in the 1.I-31.VIII.2015 period from the 1.I-31.VIII.2014 period.
