

LESS JOB VACANCIES IN THE THIRD QUARTER 2022

- In the third quarter 2022, the **number of job vacancies** was 45.3 thousand, decreasing by 0.7 thousand as against the **previous quarter**.
- The job vacancies rate¹ estimated for the 3rd quarter 2022 was 0.90%, decreasing by 0.01 percentage points as against the **previous quarter**.
- By comparison with the same quarter 2021, the job vacancies rate decreased by 0.05 percentage points and the number of job vacancies decreased by 2.0 thousand.

The rate and the number of job vacancies by economic activities

In the third quarter 2022, the **highest** <u>job</u> <u>vacancies rates</u> were registered in <u>public</u> administration (1.86%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (1.58%), respectively transportation and storage (1.57%).

In *manufacturing* was concentrated a little bit over one fourth of the <u>total number of job vacancies</u> (11.6 thousand job vacancies), and the value *rate* was 1.06%.

The budgetary sector² summed up 23% of the <u>total number of job vacancies</u>. Thus, 5.1 thousand job vacancies were found in *public administration*, 3.4 thousand job vacancies in *human health and social work activities*, and 2.0 thousand job vacancies in *education*.

¹ **Job vacancies rate** represents the ratio between number of job vacancies and total number of jobs (occupied and vacant, <u>except those blocked or meant only for promotion inside the enterprise or institution</u>), expressed in percentages.

At the opposite side, the <u>job vacancies rate</u> registered the **lowest** values in *other service* activities (0.24%) and in *mining and quarrying* (0.28%).


The **fewest** <u>job vacancies</u> were found in *real* estate activities, other service activities, respectively in mining and quarrying (0.1 thousand job vacancies each).

Quarter III 2022 compared to previous periods

As against the **previous quarter**, the <u>job</u> <u>vacancies rate</u> registered mainly **increases**, and the most relevant were in *financial and insurance activities* (+0.44 percentage points), respectively in *education* (+0.23 percentage points).

As concerning the <u>number of job vacancies</u>, this knew the most important **increases** in <u>education</u> (+0.8 thousand job vacancies), in <u>financial and insurance activities</u>, respectively in <u>administrative and support service activities</u> (+0.4 thousand job vacancies each).

At the opposite side, the most significant decreases, for both the <u>rate</u> and the <u>number of job vacancies</u>, were found in <u>human health and social work activities</u> (-0.51 percentage points, respectively -1.9 thousand job vacancies), respectively <u>information and communication</u> (-0.33 percentage points, respectively -0.7 thousand job vacancies).

As against the same quarter of the previous year, the most significant increases of the <u>job</u> <u>vacancies rate</u> were in <u>financial</u> and insurance activities (+0.59 percentage points), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (+0.40 percentage points), respectively in <u>professional</u>, <u>scientific</u> and technical activities (+0.33 percentage points).

As regarding the <u>number of job vacancies</u>, the most important **increases** were noticed in manufacturing (+1.3 thousand job vacancies), followed by transportation and storage, administrative and support service activities, respectively in professional, scientific and technical activities (+0.6 thousand job vacancies each).

At the opposite side, as regarding the <u>job</u> <u>vacancies rate</u>, the most relevant **decreases** were in *human health and social work activities* (-0.82 percentage points), in *arts, entertainment and recreation* (-0.39 percentage points), in *education* (-0.22 percentage points), respectively in *public administration* (-0.19 percentage points).

As concerning the <u>number of job vacancies</u>, significant **decreases** were noticed in *human health and social work activities* (-2.8 thousand job vacancies), *wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles* (-1.4 thousand job vacancies), *education* (-0.7 thousand job vacancies), respectively *public administration* (-0.6 thousand job vacancies).

The rate and the number of job vacancies by major groups of occupations

In the third quarter 2022, the **highest** values of the <u>job vacancies rate</u> were registered for occupations related to <u>professionals</u> – major group 2 and <u>clerical support workers</u> – major group 4 (1.23% each).

The <u>number of job vacancies</u>, registered the **highest** values for the occupations related to *professionals* — major group 2 (+14.0 thousand job vacancies) and in *elementary occupations* — major group 9 (+6.2 thousand job vacancies).


The **lowest** values for both indicators were registered in occupations related to *managers* – major group 1 (0.49%, respectively 1.8 thousand job vacancies) and *skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers* – major group 6 (0.33%, respectively 0.1 thousand job vacancies).

Quarter III 2022 compared to previous periods

As against **the previous quarter**, the <u>job</u> <u>vacancies rate</u> registered mainly **decreases**, and the most important was found in occupations related to *skilled agricultural*, *forestry and fishery*

workers – major group 6 (-0.17 percentage points).

The <u>number of job vacancies</u> knew more relevant **decreases** for occupation related to <u>service</u> and <u>sales workers</u> – major group 5 (-0.4 thousand job vacancies), respectively <u>technicians</u> and <u>associate professionals</u> – major group 3 (-0.3 thousand job vacancies).



*) pp – percentage points <u>Graph data (xls)</u> At the opposite side, the most relevant **increase** for both the <u>rate</u> and the <u>number of job vacancies</u> was registered for occupations related to <u>clerical support workers</u> — major group 4 (+0.08 percentage points, respectively +0.3 thousand job vacancies).

As against the same quarter of the previous year, with the exception of the occupations related to plant and machine operators and assemblers — major group 8 (+0.17 percentage points, respectively +0.9 thousand job vacancies) and clerical support workers — major group 4 (+0.08 percentage points, respectively +0.2 thousand job vacancies), both indicators registered decreases for all major groups of occupations, the most relevant being for occupations related to service and sales workers — major group 5 (-0.23 percentage points, respectively -1.8 thousand job vacancies).
