
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Domain: Annual Gross domestic product – semi-final version

THE GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCTS IN 2018 WAS, IN REAL TERMS, BY 4.4% HIGHER, AS COMPARED TO 2017.

The Gross Domestic Product evolution during 2005-2018 is shown in the graph below.

The Gross Domestic Product estimated for 2018 – semi-final data amounted to 952396.8 million lei current prices, increasing – in real terms – by 4.4% as against 2017.

As compared to the provisional version, in the semi-final version, the Gross Domestic Product estimated for 2017 increased by 0.9%.

The contribution of resources and uses to the growth rate of GDP

Ressources

In 2018, changes in the contribution to GDP growth, between the two estimates, were recorded for:

- Construction, from -0.3% to -0.1%, as consequence of changing the activity volume by +4.6 percentage points (from 94.4% to 99.0%);
- Wholesale and retail; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles; transport and storage; hotels and restaurants, from +0.7% to +0.8%, as consequence of changing the activity volume by +0.3 percentage points (from 103.9% to 104.2%);
- Financial intermediation and insurance, from 0.0% to +0.1%, as consequence of changing the activity volume by +2.0 percentage points (from 100.8% to 102.8%);
- Public administration and defence; social insurance of public sector; education; health and social assistance, from +0.2% to +0.3%, as consequence of changing the activity volume by +0.6 percentage points (from 101.6% to 102.2%);

Shows, culture and recreation activities; repair of households goods and other services, from +0.1% to 0.0%, as consequence of changing the activity volume by -3.4 percentage points (from 103.0% to 99.6%).

Expenditure

In 2017, more important changes in the contribution to GDP growth between the two estimates were recorded for:

- Households final consumption expenditure, from +3.3% to +4.5%, as consequence of increasing its volume by 1.9 percentage points (from 105.3% to 107.2%);
- Gross Fixed Capital Formation, from -0.7% to -0.3%, as consequence of changing its volume by +2.0 percentage points (from 96.8% to 98.8%);
- Change in inventories and acquisitions less disposal of valuables , from +2.9% to +1.2%.

Revisions

The quarterly Gross Domestic Product for 2018 was revised to insure the consistency with the semi-final annula estimates of Gross Domestic Product. This led to the necessity of revising the quarterly data for the first three quarters of 2019, their estimation being based on the method of extrapolation in volumes and prices of the values of the corresponding quarter of the reference year, 2018 respectively.

The revision was based on the new macroeconomic indicator revision policy which was elaborated to comply with the Regulation (EU) 2016/2304 of 19 December 2016 on the modalities, structure, periodicity and assessment indicators of the quality reports on data transmitted pursuant to Regulation (EU) No 549/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

1) Represents the difference between taxes on product due to the State Budget (VAT, excise duties, other taxes) and product subsidies paid from the State Budget.

2) Comprises: expenditure of population households for purchasing goods and services in view to meet their members needs, the expenditure for individual consumption of public administration (education, health, social security and social activities, culture, sport, leisure activities, collection of household waste) and the expenditure for individual consumption of non-profit institutions serving households (religious organisations, trade unions, political parties, unions, foundations, cultural and sport associations).

3) Comprises the expenditure for collective consumption of public administration (general public services, national defence and territory security, public order and security, legislative and regulatory activities, research & development, etc.).
