Vital statistics in February 2015

- In February 2015, the number of births and the number of deaths decreased compared to January 2015.
- The number of deaths of children under one year dropped in February compared to January 2015.

February 2015 compared to January 2015¹

Birth rate, death rate and natural increase

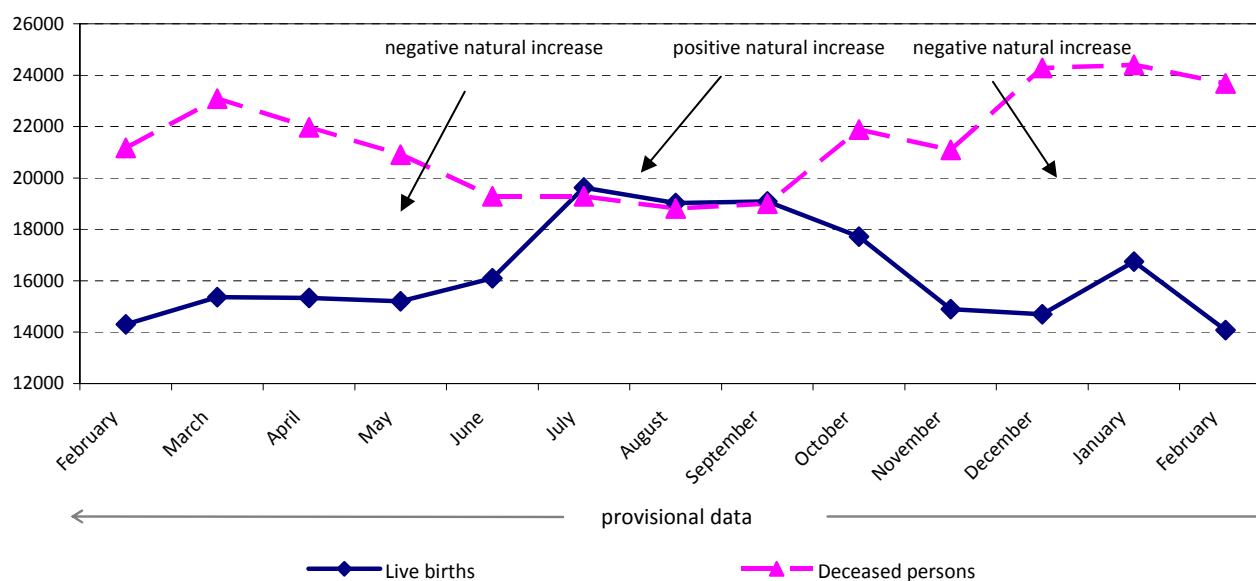
In February, the **births** of 14078 children were recorded, 2662 less than in January 2015.

The number of persons whose **deaths** were recorded in February was 23680, 722 less than in January 2015.

The **natural increase** was negative (an excess of deceased persons over live births) both in February (9602 persons) and in January (7662 persons).

The number of **deaths of children under one year** recorded in February was 112, a decrease of 40 compared to January 2015 (152 deceased persons under 1 year).

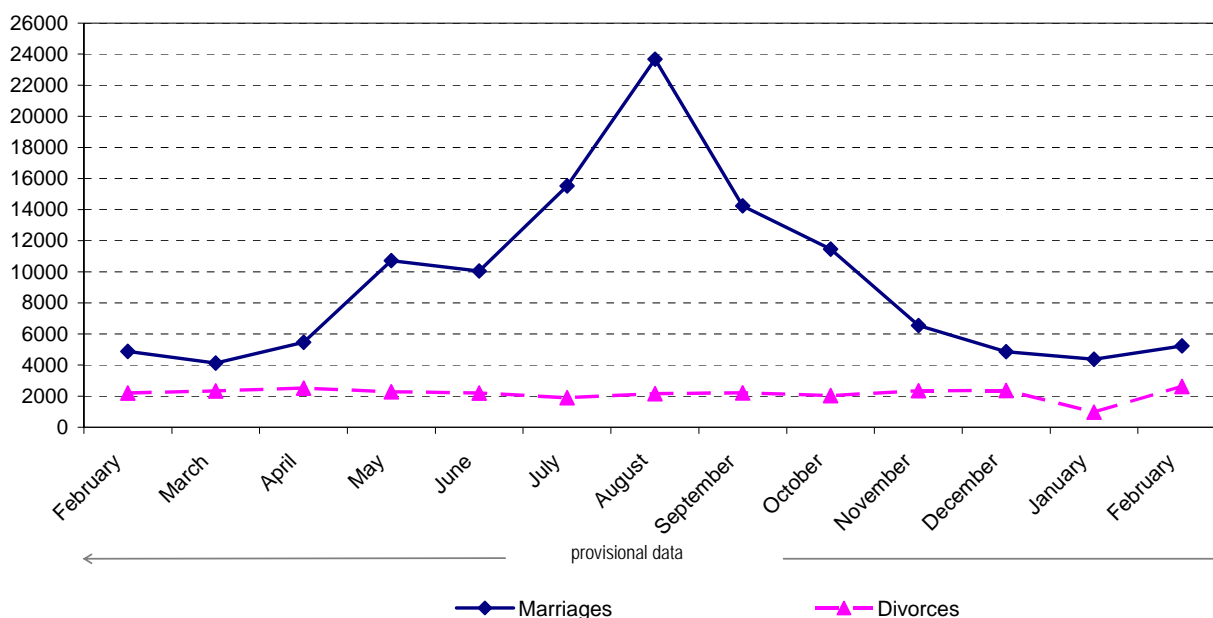

Marriage rate and divorce rate

5233 **marriages** were recorded at Register Offices in February, 869 more than in January.

2617 **divorces** were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010, 1645 more than in January.

February 2015 compared to February 2014²

Birth rate, death rate and natural increase

The number of **live births** fell by 217 in February 2015 compared to the same month of 2014, and the number of persons who **died** was higher by 2506 than in February 2014.

The **natural increase** was negative both in February 2015 (9602 persons) and in February 2014 (6879 persons).

The number of **children under one year who died** was smaller by 14 than in February 2014.

Marriage rate and divorce rate

The number of **marriages** rose by 352 in February 2015 compared to the same month of the previous year. In February 2015, 414 more **divorces** than in February 2014 were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010.
