Vital statistics in March 2015

- In March 2015, the number of births and the number of deaths rose compared to February 2015.
- The number of deaths of children under one year recorded in March was higher than in February 2015.

March 2015 compared to February 2015¹


Birth rate, death rate and natural increase


In March, the births of 15147 children were recorded, 1069 more than in February 2015.

The number of persons whose deaths were recorded in March was 25864, 2184 more than in February 2015.

The natural increase was negative (an excess of deceased persons over live births) both in March (10717 persons) and in February (9602 persons).

The number of deaths of children under one year recorded in March was 131, an increase of 19 compared to February 2015 (112 deceased persons under one year).







Marriage rate and divorce rate

4005 marriages were recorded at Register Offices in March, 1228 less than in February.

2696 **divorces** were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010, 79 more than in February.

March 2015 compared to March 2014²

Birth rate, death rate and natural increase

The number of **live births** fell by 172 in March 2015 compared to the same month of 2014, and the number of persons who **died** was higher by 2415 than in March 2014.

The **natural increase** was negative both in March 2015 (10717 persons) and in March 2014 (8130 persons).

The number of **children under one year who died** in March 2015 was smaller by 1 than in March 2014.

Marriage rate and divorce rate³

The number of **marriages** fell by 469 in March 2015 compared to the same month of the previous year. In March 2015, 64 more **divorces** than in March 2014 were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010.
