Vital statistics in June 2015

- The number of births recorded in June was higher than the one recorded in May 2015, and the number of deaths was lower in June 2015 than in May 2015.
- The number of marriages and the number of divorces recorded in June 2015 decreased compared to May 2015.

June 2015 compared to May 2015¹


Birth rate, death rate and natural increase

In June, the births of 16630 children were recorded, 1753 more than in May 2015.

The number of persons whose **deaths** were recorded in June was 19747, 735 less than in May 2015.

The **natural increase** was negative (an excess of deceased persons over live births) both in June (3117 persons) and in May (5605 persons).

The number of **deaths of children under 1 year** recorded in June was 131, an increase of 3 compared to May 2015 (128 deceased persons under one year).



Marriage rate and divorce rate

9395 marriages were recorded at Register Offices in June, 1492 less than in May 2015.

2650 **divorces** were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010, 7 less than in May.

June 2015 compared to June 2014²

Birth rate, death rate and natural increase

The number of **live births** rose by 541 in June 2015 compared to the same month of 2014, and the number of persons who **died** was higher by 331 than in June 2014.

The **natural increase** was negative in June 2015 (3117 persons) and in June 2014 (3327 persons).

The number of **children under one year who died** in June 2015 was smaller by 11 than the one recorded in June 2014.

Marriage rate and divorce rate³

The number of **marriages** decreased by 1015 in June 2015 compared to the same month of the previous year. In June 2015, 89 more **divorces** than in June 2014 were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010.
